- New Traffic Signal As information for Villages residents, we would like to inform you The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has implemented a new type of traffic signal at certain locations throughout the state and at some intersections adjacent to The Villages. The signals now include a flashing yellow arrow. It is a new type of signal which is placed over a left turn lane at a signalized intersection where one of the signal indications is a flashing yellow arrow. They are the result of a national study conducted by the Federal Highway Administration, which demonstrated many benefits. - Budget the FY14/15 Budgets were adopted in September for the new fiscal year 2014-15 that began on October 1<sup>st</sup>

- Community Standards At the November meeting, District 9 Board of Supervisors will take
  the first step to enforcement of External Deed Restrictions and to join the Architectural
  Review Committee with Districts 1-8 and VCCDD for Lady Lake & Lake County.
  - It is anticipated that the Board will approve the Memorandum of Agreement between The Villages of Lake-Sumter and VCDD 9 and the timeline associated with the implementation of the process and adoption of their Rule to Bring About Deed Compliance.
- Golf El Santiago will be closed for the next 3 days for over seeding
  - Overseeding is the process of planting seed into existing turf grass. This process is used to establish cool season grasses that grow better in and during cooler temperatures than the warm season grasses we have in Florida. It enhances player satisfaction by supplying smoother playing surfaces, a brighter green color and culturally helps protect the dormant Bermuda grass through the winter months.
- Property Management The lighted stop bollards located on the multimodal path at North
  Morse Circle will be relocated approximately 18" to assist in keeping traffic on the path moving
  in the correct traffic pattern and at a safe speed.

- Public Safety Daylight Savings Time came to an end on Sunday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> and marked the 27<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Change Your Clock – Change Your Battery Program
