


The following facilities will be closed on the dates noted for scheduled maintenance this week:

NOTICE OF VACANCY VILLAGE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 2 BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Village Community Development District No. 2 Board of Supervisors is seeking applicants who are interested in filling Seat 4, which was recently vacated due to the passing of Supervisor Nick Jones. The remainder of the existing four (4) year term for the vacated Seat will expire in November 2016.

Any interested applicants must be a qualified elector which is defined by Florida Statute 190 as "any person at least 18 years of age who is a citizen of the United States, a legal resident of Florida and of the district, and who registers to vote with the Supervisor of Elections in the county in which the district land is located". 

As our seasonal residents begin arriving, I would like to take a moment to remind everyone where our offices are located and



some of the services and opportunities we provide.

With the exception of Community Watch and Public Safety, all District offices are at 984 Old Mill Run in Lake Sumter Landing. You can visit the District Administration offices, pick up or submit an Architectural Review Committee home/property alteration application at the Community Standards department, visit the Recreation Administration department to reserve a room at your favorite recreation center, or speak with the Human Resources department regarding available District job openings, all in one convenient location.

Stop by the Customer Service Center if you need to replace or obtain information on your Villages Resident ID Card or any of your gate access cards. If you need to replace any of your gate access cards, please remember to bring in all of your cards as they are issued in sets.

You can also speak to a customer service representative about some of the other services we provide, such as the Adopt-A-Bench program or renting a parking space in one of our recreational vehicle storage facilities.

The Customer Service Center is also an additional location to purchase executive trail fees or request guest IDs when your friends or family come to visit.

Customer Service Representatives are available from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. Monday through Friday to assist you with any questions you may have about the community. Phone number inquiries, directions to recreation facilities and general community information are just a few of the questions they receive and answer each day.

Representatives are also available to speak with you pertaining to your monthly utility and amenity bill or your bond assessment. For additional information on any of the services mentioned above or if you need to know who to contact for additional services, please feel free to call us at 753-4508.

Many of the services I listed above can also be accessed by visiting our website, districtgov. org. Check the News & Information and What's Happening sections daily to learn about communitywide events and information.

If you prefer we contact you with upcoming events and information such as road and recreation center closures, take a moment to sign up for E-Notifications.

For those of you not familiar with our website, I urge you to attend one of our Welcome Wednesday sessions occurring at 11 a.m. each Wednesday at the District offices. Each week we will feature a new area of the website and teach you how to navigate through it.


Each week we are highlighting different services available on the website, www.DistrictGov.org. This week's feature includes obtaining information on your sanitation and recycling collection.

Political Activities on District Property

With the General Election taking place in 2016, the political activities in the community will be increasing. As information, the District has put together information for the expectations in the community:

Pursuant to the District rules, there is no soliciting in the three downtowns: Spanish Springs, Lake Sumter Landing and Brownwood. Candidates and their supporters are permitted in the downtown areas. The squares are for the benefit and enjoyment of the residents/public, and they should not be approached or solicited.

Candidates and their supporters are permitted to stand on the exterior of District owned property such as postal facilities and recreation centers, but are not permitted to obstruct the free flow of pedestrian or vehicular traffic, interfere with scheduled activities or hassle individuals.
