Retention Pond—Bailey Trail and Buena Vista Boulevard

In an effort to properly maintain and prevent further damage to the grass and landscaped area on the south and west ends of the retention pond at Bailey Trail, a fence will be installed to allow **pedestrian traffic only**. There will be no golf cart access. In an effort to inform residents about the installation of the fence, signs will be placed around the retention area by District staff. We appreciate your assistance and cooperation to continue to maintain this beautiful community.



Road Closure

SECO will be removing large power poles at the corner of Morse Boulevard and Hwy 44 on Wednesday, May 11, 2016. While the work is performed, Morse Boulevard will be closed south of Kristine Way at the Soaring Eagle Softball Complex. A detour will be provided along Kristine Way. Please use caution in this area and pay attention to all detour and directional signage.

- Do not place unwanted phone books at your postal facility. They should be placed in the bag and discarded with your household recycling
- Do not tape or affix flyers or other paperwork on the exterior of the bulletin boards or other areas of the postal facility. For information on posting material in the bulletin boards, please contact Customer Service at (352) 753-4508 or visit www.DistrictGov.org.

Did You Know??

The bulletin boards located at the postal facilities provide a communication resource for Villages neighborhood groups and the District Government for neighborhood and community wide events and information.

- All items must be approved by the District before posting
- Items shall not be posted to exceed two (2) weeks or until the post is no longer valid
- Any type of notice posted to the outside of the bulletin board or posted without prior approval will be removed and discarded

The following items will not be approved for posting at any time:

- Commercial services / activities
- Charitable activities / organizations
- Religious material
- Club recruitment / membership notices
- Petitions
- Items or services for sale
- Materials that oppose or support political candidates or ballot measures

To submit an item for posting, please:

- Visit the Customer Service Center at 984 Old Mill Run to drop off the posting
- Email the item to customerservice@districtgov.org
- Place the item in the Utility / Amenity / District Correspondence drop box located at each postal facility
- Include your name, contact information, post and removal date and posting location

A Message From...



Each election period raises questions about allowable campaign activities within the Village Community Development Districts, including signage. To help all candidates and supporters, we have prepared an overview of signage enforcement for each District. Any questions with regard to signage or political activities should be directed to Janet Tutt, District Manager or Diane Tucker, Administrative Operations Manager at (352)-751-3939.

- ⇒ **No signs** may be placed on, or affixed to District owned property.
- ⇒ Signs may be affixed to golf carts or Low Speed Vehicles or held by candidates or their supporters.
- ⇒ **Lady Lake/Lake County:**

The placement of not more than one (1) professionally prepared sign not exceeding twenty-four (24) inches wide and twenty-four (24) inches high affixed to an exterior window of a home unit, any content is permitted. There is no enforcement of for rent/for sale signs in villa units; however, no other signage is permitted with the exception of security and lawn care signs as designated in the Rule.
- ⇒ **VCDD No. 1:**

No enforcement of signs in home or villa units.
- ⇒ **VCDD No. 2 & VCDD No. 3:**

The placement of not more than one (1) professionally prepared sign not exceeding twenty-four (24) inches wide and twenty-four (24) inches high affixed to an exterior window of a home unit, any content is permitted. There is no enforcement of for rent/for sale signs in villa units; however, no other signage is permitted with the exception of security and lawn care signs as designated in the Rule.
- ⇒ **VCDD No. 4:**

No enforcement of signs in home or villa units.
- ⇒ **VCDD No. 5-10:**

No sign of any kind shall be displayed to public view on a Homesite or any dedicated or reserved area without prior written consent, except customary name and address signs and one sign advertising a property for sale or rent which shall be no larger than twelve (12) inches wide and twelve (12) inches high and which shall be located wholly within the Home and only visible through a window of the Home with the exception of security and lawn care signs.
