The following facilities will be closed or have scheduled maintenance:

⇒ Brinson-Perry Dog Park

The Brinson-Perry Dog Park will be closed for maintenance until Monday, May 30th.

⇒ Rio Grande Lawn Bowling & Croquet Court

The Rio Grande Lawn Bowling & Croquet Courts are currently closed for maintenance. They are scheduled to re-open on May 24th.

⇒ Chula Vista Golf Course

Summer Time Awareness

Officially the first day of Summer is June 21st,

but we are already experiencing the higher temperatures. As residents continue to stay active during the warmer months, it's a good time to review the current heat index guidelines. Awareness, staying hydrated and keeping cool will help

beat the heat for the next few months.

In an effort to ensure the long term health of playing surfaces, we have designed a bi-weekly course closure schedule for the summer. This schedule allows contractors to perform maintenance tasks that otherwise could not be performed on our native Bermuda grass species while over seeded in the winter months.

We understand this can be an inconvenience for a while. Some of the maintenance programs we perform such as aeration and top dressing sand are the single most important Bermuda grass and soil compaction relief recovery tools we have to get through the transition period. These both occur throughout the summer and take 14 to 21 days for the course to recover. Please check the website and schedule your tee times accordingly to help accommodate the summer closing schedule. We appreciate your assistance and understanding!
