Del Mar Gate

Villa Road Maintenance

Resurfacing will be taking place on the villa roads in the Pinecrest and Ivystone Villas Monday, September 19, 2016 through Friday, September 23, 2016. This schedule may be adjusted due to unforeseen circumstances, including weather. Please park all vehicles and trailers off of the roadway and overflow parking areas while this work is complete. Newly paved roadways will take approximately one hour to cure and should NOT be driven on while hot. Each home impacted by this work will be notified and given specific safety instructions. North Morse Boulevard Roundabout

Several strips of asphalt will be reworked on the North Morse Boulevard Roundabout:

Morse Boulevard, exiting the roundabout onto Paige Place Exiting the roundabout onto Morse Boulevard, heading south – visitors lane Existing roundabout onto Morse Boulevard, heading south - resident lane

This work is scheduled to begin on September 20, 2016 at 8:00am, weather permitting. The overall rework process should take approximately 3-4 hours. Amenity Authority Committee Landowner Election Information

A Landowner Election will be held on <u>Tuesday, November 8, 2016</u> (Election Day) to select a District 4 Representative for the Amenity Authority Committee (AAC) at the Mulberry Regional Recreation Center in the Justice Room - This is a separate location then where you will cast your vote for the General Election. You may cast your vote in the Landowner Election from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m.

If you are not able to vote in person on November 8th have two other options to cast your vote:

Obtain an Application for an Absentee Ballot from the www.districtgov.org website or from the District Office at 984 Old Mill Run located in Lake Sumter Landing beginning on September 26, 2016; or

Early Voting will be held at the District Office at 984 Old Mill Run in Lake Sumter Landing from 8:00 a.m. until 5 p.m. from October 25, 2016 – November 4, 2016.

**Please note: A Landowner Election provides for one vote per parcel of property only. **



Campaign Sign Information

Each election period raises questions about allowable campaign activities within the Village Community Development Districts, including signage. To help all candidates and supporters, we have prepared an overview of signage enforcement for each District. Any questions with regard to signage or political activities should be directed to Janet Tutt, District Manager or Diane Tucker, Administrative Operations Manager at (352)-751-3939.

⇒ Lady Lake/Lake County:

The placement of not more than one (1) professionally prepared sign not exceeding twenty-four (24) inches wide and twenty-four (24) inches high affixed to an exterior window of a home unit, any content is permitted. There is no enforcement of for rent/for sale signs in villa units; however, no other signage is permitted with the exception of security and lawn care signs as designated in the Rule.

⇒ VCDD No. 1:

No enforcement of signs in home or villa units.

⇒ VCDD No. 2 & VCDD No. 3:

The placement of not more than one (1) professionally prepared sign not exceeding twenty-four (24) inches wide and twenty-four (24) inches high affixed to an exterior window of a home unit, any content is permitted. There is no enforcement of for rent/for sale signs in villa units; however, no other signage is permitted with the exception of security and lawn care signs as designated in the Rule.

⇒ **VCDD No. 4:**

No enforcement of signs in home or villa units.

⇒ **VCDD No. 5-11:**

No sign of any kind shall be displayed to public view on a Homesite or any dedicated or reserved area without prior written consent, except customary name and address signs and one sign advertising a property for sale or rent which shall be no larger than twelve (12) inches wide and twelve (12) inches high and which shall be located wholly within the Home and only visible through a window of the Home with the exception of security and lawn care signs.

- \Rightarrow Signs may not be affixed to the exterior walls of District owned property.
- ⇒ Signs may be affixed to golf carts or Low Speed Vehicles or held by candidates or their supporters.

Did You Know??



The Villages Public Safety Department urges you to be prepared during hurricane season. A Hurricane Personal Preparedness booklet can be found on www.DistrictGov.org. When preparing your home and family—please keep the following tips in mind:

DON'T WAIT—Do not wait for a storm forecast before preparing your disaster supply kit! For information on items that should be included in your kit—visit www.DistrictGov.org.

HAVE A PLAN—Depending on whether you plan on evacuating in the event of a storm or staying put, you need to have a plan in place. If you plan on evacuating, do you know where you are heading? If you plan on staying home, do you have a "safe room" prepared in your home?

PERSONAL PREPARDNESS CHECKLIST-

- Develop disaster and first aid supply kits
- Store loose outdoor patio items / furniture
- Prune trees or weak / dead branches
- Place vital documents in waterproof containers
- Remove and secure valuables
- Develop a plan for handling your pets
- Register physically challenged persons with the appropriate emergency management offices
- · Register with your county emergency notification system
- Become familiar with the area's disaster plan and evacuation routes
- Prepare a safe room in your house
- Set a family rallying or meeting point
- Make an inventory of your home's contents—photos or video tape. Collectables need special attention
- Check your insurance coverage—is it adequate?
- Develop a communication plan with relatives and friends NOW!
- Cash—make sure it is small bills

STAY IN TOUCH—staying apprised of information via local radio & television stations is essential in helping your family recover.


