Hurricane Matthew

The Villages Public Safety Department with District Administration are monitoring Hurricane Matthew. Part of the preparedness plan for the District involves the removal of gate arms. When wind conditions are predicted to become strong, the gate arms will be removed. During this time, we ask the residents to use extreme caution when traveling through or around the gates. When conditions improve, gate arms will be replaced to normal operations.

Pending further movement by Hurricane Matthew and potential impact to The Villages, there may be closings of facilities and activities. We, again, are monitoring closely and will update you through the media, the District website, and E-notification. Should closings be necessary, it will be for the safety of both ours staff and residents. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause but, your safety is our utmost concern.

Sanitation Collection Cancellation

Due to the expected inclement weather from Hurricane Matthew, residents living in the Sumter County, Marion County and Fruitland Park portions of The Villages will not have sanitation or recycling collection on Friday, October 7, 2016. Ribbon Curbing Installation

The installation of ribbon curbing began September 20, 2016 at Antrim Dells. This curbing will inhibit the growth of grass into the asphalt on the streets. The following facility will be closed or have scheduled maintenance:

⇒ Paradise Dog Park

The Paradise Dog Park is scheduled to be closed October 12th through October 14th for maintenance.

⇒ Lake Shore Cottages Pool

The Lake Shore Cottages Pool will be closed to replace the door jambs in the restrooms October 10th from 7am—12pm and October 11th from 7am—12pm.

⇒ Chatham Recreation Center

The Chatham Recreation Center will be closed for sprinkler system upgrades on Wednesday, October 12th.

Paver Crossing Maintenance

Construction is scheduled to begin on the paver crossing at Old Mill Run and Old Camp Road on Wednesday, October 5, 2016. This project will be completed in four phases. The work will consist of reworking the sidewalks at each corner of Old Mill Run and Old Camp Road and installing brick pavers inside the new concrete

Landscape & Irrigation Renovations

Silver Lake Recreation Center—Irrigation upgrades are complete and landscaping renovations are underway. New plant material is currently being installed. We anticipate this project will be complete next week.





Paradise Recreation Center—Landscape renovations are now complete. New trees and plantings have been installed throughout the property.

El Camino Real—All new electric valves have been set and the new control wires are being installed. We anticipate this project will be complete early to mid-November.



Villa Road Maintenance

Pavement resurfacing will be taking place at the Springdale Community Development Districts Entry, Piedmont Entry, and Birchbrook Villa roads Monday, October 3, 2016 through Friday, October 7, 2016. This

schedule may be adjusted due to unforeseen circumstances, including weather. Work on the Gate Entries will be conducted at night to avoid traffic backups. Expect lane closures and temporary closures of the gate entries. When closed, please use the Chatham and Briar Meadow South gates. Birchbrook Villa residents should avoid parking in the street until the villa work is complete. Newly paved roadways will take approximately one hour to cure and should NOT be driven on while hot. Each home impacted by this work will be notified and given specific safety instructions. Please use caution and follow all directional signage and workers. Executive Golf

On Thursday, September 22nd, the calendar said it was the first day of fall. On that day, many courses received a little under a 1/2 inch of rain and overnight temperatures fell to 71 degrees. That was a great way to start our first fall day and start our golf courses transition into the month of October.

In this upcoming month, our golf management community will be preparing for the busy months of winter play. Our golf maintenance contractors will be starting their fall over seeding of the designated golf course playing surfaces as well. Please remember to check your tee times for these occurrences.

Also, please remember the courses will have the normal 3 day closures for over seed and several blocked tee times throughout the upcoming weeks for over seed, irrigation and establishment. These closures will ensure superintendents get the proper amounts of seeding completed on all greens and tees. After 21 to 28 days with proper weather, the over seed should be fully established and your playing conditions should be ideal through the winter months

As a friendly reminder, if you see players not golfing on tees ahead of you and notice gaps in your tee times, the starter may be holding some tee times open to facilitate additional watering cycles for over seeded areas. Please be patient!

TURF TIP:

Overseeding-The process of planting seed into existing turf grass. We use this process to establish cool season grasses that grow better in and during cooler temperatures then our warm season grasses here in Florida. This enhances your playing satisfaction by supplying smoother playing surfaces and more colorful playing conditions

The District celebrates the start of its new Fiscal Year 2016-17 on October 1st! If we add the approved budgets for the 48 Funds then the total FY2016-17 Budget is \$256,067,199! Thanks to the Budget team which includes 82 Board members, 12 members of 2 Committees, District staff along with residents that have provided input and attended budget workshops/board meetings.

OPERATION MEDICINE CABINET

The Sumter County Sheriff's Office will be sponsoring Operation Medicine Cabinet. This will give Sumter County residents a chance to dispose of unused or expired prescriptions.

The event will be held on Saturday October 22, 2016 in front of RJ Gators restaurant on the sidewalk in the Lake Sumter town square located at 1015 Lake Shore Drive The Villages.

Deputies will be on hand to retrieve the discarded medicines from 7am to 10:30am.

Proper disposal prevents the medicine from being stolen or abused. Thrown into the garbage, pharmaceuticals can end up leeching into the environment. Flushed down a toilet the medicines can contaminate groundwater supply. Disposing of unused or expired medicine will also keep children and grandchildren from getting into the prescriptions.

Operation Medicine Cabinet provides a safe way of destroying pharmaceuticals through incineration, to avoid polluting the environment. Help us keep medications from getting into the wrong hands or our water supply.
