The Manatee Shuffleboard Courts will be closed for resurfacing December 5th through December 9th.

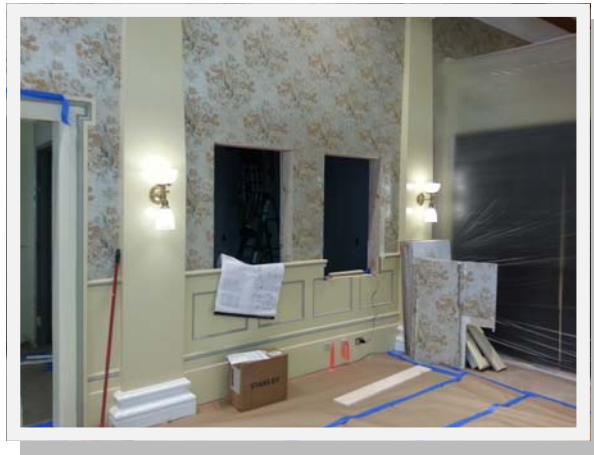
⇒ **Sterling Heights Shuffleboard Courts**

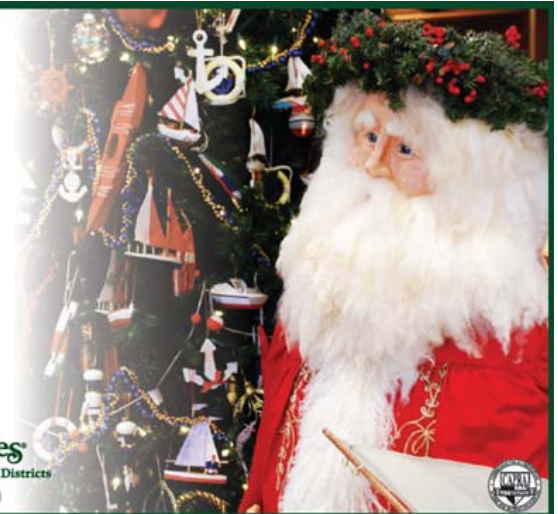

Remaining off the playing surface is extremely important. Please be patient and wait for your starters to give the all clear before proceeding onto any turf surfaces.
