As our Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget process winds to an end, we will be providing carryforward resolutions to the pertinent District Boards for adoption at their December board meetings. The carryforward process allows the District to move unspent appropriated funds for approved items or projects that were not completed or entirely paid for during Fiscal Year 2015-16 to the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget.

On December 7,2016 the Village Center Community Development District Board (VCCDD) authorized staff to review and gather information regarding the resources and operational aspects of trying to establish and manage a program similar to the Lifelong Learning College.
