⇒ Savannah Center Shuffleboard & Bocce Courts

Saddlebrook Village Recreation Center Renovation

The foundation and framing of the new addition to the billiards room is scheduled to begin this week. The mechanical, plumbing and electrical rough in stage will begin shortly. What's Happening in Your District





The District Property Management Department is coordinating with Rainey Construction to mill and overlay the Villa roads in VCDD No. 5 and 6 that were not previously completed. The work is scheduled to begin on January 16, 2017 and continue through June 2017.

The District will deliver notices to each home that will be impacted by the work approximately 7-10 days in advance, in addition to placing informational signs at the entry and exit of each villa which will include the anticipated start and end date of the project.

The timeline may be adjusted due to unforeseen circumstances, including weather. If the timeline is adjusted, the informational signs at the villa entry and exits will be updated.

The District thanks you in advance for your cooperation to ensure this is a successful project, and encourages you to adhere to the instructions that you will receive in the future.

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE Is seeking an alternate committee member for Village Community Development District No. 6

Village Community Development District No. 6 is seeking a volunteer to serve as an alternate committee member for the Architectural Review Committee (ARC). The applicant must be a full time resident of Village Community Development District No. 6 and have lived in The Villages for at least one year. Committee members are recommended to have education and/or experience in any of the following areas: architecture, ability to read site plans, residential/commercial construction, building management, deed restricted communities, landscaping, county code enforcement, etc; however, this is not required. The Committee meets weekly, on Wednesdays, for approximately 3 hours (8:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m.).

The required attendance for the alternate is to attend an ARC meeting each week for four (4) weeks and then monthly thereafter. The term for the alternate committee members is 4 years.

Scheduled Maintenance of the Orange Blossom Hills Water Tower

Beginning Monday, January 30, 2017 Utility Service Group, A District Contractor, will be on site at the Orange Blossom Hills Water Tower in the Lady Lake area of The Villages to clean and paint the Water Tower.
