### **Road Rejuvenation – Village Community Development District No. 10**

Road rejuvenation is scheduled to begin on villa roads located within District 10 Tuesday, May 9, 2017 through Friday, May 19, 2017. Door knockers will be delivered as a reminder the week before work begins and signs will be placed at your Villa entry approximately two weeks before work begins. Please check the signs at your entry for dates of application and check daily for any changes which may occur that are out of our control. Additional information can also be found by visiting www.DistrictGov.org.

We <u>strongly recommend</u> you follow all instructions given to you by the workers in your Villa and the information provided on the doorknocker you will receive. Some of these instructions include no car washing, no parking in the street or in the guest parking area. We appreciate your patience and cooperation while we complete this necessary road maintenance to extend the life of the road infrastructure.

It is extremely important that you do not run any irrigation or wash your car the day before, the day of and the day after application. The product being used needs to completely soak into the asphalt on a dry road to ensure a successful application.

All multimodal trails will also receive a reclamite application. This project will be a night time operation and should have little to no impact on cart traffic.

The District Property Management Department is coordinating with Rainey Construction to mill and overlay the Villa roads in VCDD No. 5 and 6 that were not previously completed. The work began on January 16, 2017 and will continue through July 2017.

The District will deliver notices to each home that will be impacted by the work approximately 7-10 days in advance, in addition to placing informational signs at the entry and exit of each villa which will include the anticipated start and end date of the project.

The timeline may be adjusted due to unforeseen circumstances, including weather. If the timeline is adjusted, the informational signs at the villa entry and exits will be updated.

# Just a Reminder...

Due to the lack of rain fall, Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD), the state water management agency for our area, declared a Phase I Water Shortage that was effective March 10, 2017 for portions of Lake, Marion and Sumter counties and includes The Villages. The Phase I declaration was put in place to inform the public to be aware of the shortage and to practice water conservation. Putting a priority on water conservation will help to protect our precious water resources.

SWFWMD recently modified the Phase I water shortage restrictions to extend through July 31, 2017, and the water shortage restrictions now encompass all of SWFWMD. The restrictions include the following;

- Lawn watering is limited to twice per week.
- Lawn watering days and times are as follows
- o Lawn watering must occur before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m.
- For days and specific times for home in The Villages, please refer to www.thevillageswaterwisdom.com/irrigation-schedules

Hand watering and micro-irrigation of plants (other than lawns) can be done on any day and any time.

SWFWMD and the District recommend year-round water conservation. Water levels rise and fall, but our water resources remain limited. The District encourages efficient, non-wasteful uses of water to sustain our high quality of life. For more information about ways to conserve water visit the District website at

The Villages® Community Development Districts Executive Golf

In our efforts to be proactive to current weather conditions, we are currently restricting cart traffic on certain Executive Courses. Cart traffic traveling on turf that is stressed due to drought conditions can cause significant long term damage to turf areas, including high compaction. In an effort to counteract this growing problem, District Executive Golf will be scheduling courses that are cart path only based on current conditions. This schedule can be monitored through the tee time system and will be updated on the District web site at districtgov.org throughout the coming months until we return to our normal summer weather patterns.

El Diablo golf course will remain open the week of May 15th to May 21st. This course will be closed for summer renovations and reconstruction starting May 22nd.

The El Santiago Executive golf course will remain closed for further recovery from extensive fall play of our larger cups. The new course is progressing extremely well and recovery from a successful high amount of winter play needs to continue so we may reopen with the same quality conditioning this fall.


