Storm Water Management

To ensure adequate capacity of the storm water management system throughout the community, the District will be lowering certain water retention areas that are above recommended levels. The water level is being lowered to ensure there is sufficient capacity in the water retention area to capture water run-off from streets, yards and golf courses in preparation of future rain events. To lower the water level in water retention basins, irrigation systems will run along common areas and roadways throughout the community. This is currently occurring along El Camino Real. 2017 MILL AND OVERLAY SCHEDULE
Updated 7/31/17

The District Property Management Department is coordinating with Rainey Construction to mill and overlay several roadway areas.

The District will deliver notices to each home that will be impacted by the work approximately 7-10 days in advance, in addition to placing informational signs at the entry and exit of each villa which will include the anticipated start and end date of the project.

The timeline may be adjusted due to unforeseen circumstances, including weather. If the timeline is adjusted, the informational signs at the villa entry and exits will be updated.

Please use caution and follow all flagman directions and signage. Newly paved roadways will take approximately one hour to cure and should NOT be driven on while hot.

The District thanks you in advance for your cooperation to ensure this is a successful project, and encourages you to adhere to the instructions that you will receive in the future.





Sumter County Road Work

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE

Is seeking a primary and alternate volunteer committee member for Village Community Development District No. 10

Village Community Development District No. 10 (District 10) is seeking a primary representative to complete a four (4) year term and an alternate representative to complete a four (4) year term on the Architectural Review Committee (ARC).

The **primary applicant** must be a full time resident of District No. 10 and have lived in The Villages for at least one year.

The **alternate applicant** must be a full time resident of District No. 10 and have lived in The Villages for at least one year. This position requires attendance at the ARC meeting every week for the first four (4) weeks and once every month thereafter.

Candidates are recommended to have education and/or experience in any of the following areas: architecture, ability to read site plans, residential/commercial construction, building management, deed restricted communities, landscaping, county code enforcement, etc; however, this is not required. The Committee meets weekly, on Wednesdays, for approximately 3 1/2 hours (8:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m.).

Phase III Water Shortage Order Extended

On July 25, 2017, The Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD), the state water management agency for our area, extended the Phase III Water Shortage order for the Northern Region, which includes The Villages until October 1, 2017. The Environmental Protection Rate Surcharge as outlined in the water and sewer rates of 10% for water use only will remain in effect for the duration of the water shortage order.

Please keep in mind that this continues to restrict residential and commercial irrigation of lawns and landscaping to one day per week following the schedule printed below before 8:00 AM or after 6:00 PM.

Ending in 0 or 1	Monday
Ending in 2 or 3	Tuesday
Ending in 4 or 5	Wednesday
Ending in 6 or 7	Thursday
Ending in 8 or 9	Friday
No address (community common areas, etc.)	Friday

SWFWMD considers both natural water resource conditions and the viability of public supply when deciding to declare a water shortage order. For the past 20 years SWFWMD has worked diligently with its partners to develop alternative water supplies. Even though the region is experiencing drought conditions, there is adequate public water supply available.
