December/January Turf Talk

The Thanksgiving Holiday has passed with much fan fare and we are sledding straight into December and January. November brought some cooler weather and positive playing conditions entering into the winter months after the fall over seeding.

During the month of December, we will be implementing the biweekly golf course closure schedule. The success we achieved last year with this program will continue for this month. These short closures will allow the contractors to do the extra necessary maintenance and to help maintain quality conditions throughout the winter months during these full tee times.

These closure days in December will help ensure playing conditions are met and kept long into January. Our goal is to ensure the best playing conditions possible as we carry forward into the 2018 transitional time period.

Frost delays have not been implemented so far this year and we are thankful for this. Please be aware, however when we do have frost delays on courses this is strictly to protect the plants from desiccation and permanent damage.

Remaining off the playing surface is extremely important. Please be patient and wait for your starters to give the all clear before

proceeding onto any turf surfaces.

Over seeding-

The process of planting seed into existing warm season turf grass. We use this process to establish cool season grasses that grow better in and during cooler temperatures then our warm season grasses here in Florida. This enhances your playing satisfaction by supplying smoother playing surfaces and more colorful playing conditions.
