Another big part of Florida Severe Weather Awareness Week is the tornado drill which will be conducted on Wednesday, January 24th at 10:00 AM EST. As in previous years, this will consist of the NOAA Weather Radio receivers being activated using the 'routine weekly test' code (i.e., same code used to activate the weekly Wednesday tests) and a TEST tornado warning message playing on the radio.
