Road rejuvenation is scheduled to take place on villa roads in District 5, District 6 and District 11. Door hangers and signs at the villa entries will be placed in all areas that will be impacted by this work. Please check the signs at your villa entry for application dates, as well as changes due to unforeseen circumstances.

This work is scheduled to begin on March 12, 2018 and be complete on March 23, 2018. Please understand that these dates may change due to equipment issues, rain delays or irrigation not being turned off. It is extremely important that you do not run your irrigation or do any car washing the day before, the day of and the day after application. 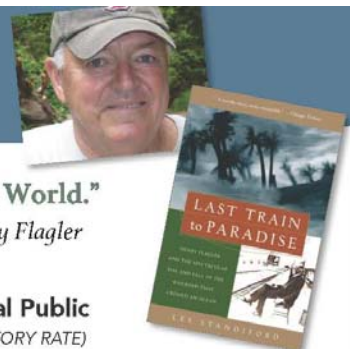

A kick-off meeting was held last week with the Budget Preparation Team and District staff is busy preparing their requested budget packets! This budget process will result in a final adopted budget for Fiscal Year 2018-19 which will begin on October 1, 2018 and end on September 30, 2019.
