What's Happening in Your District...



Road rejuvenation is scheduled to take place on villa roads in District 5, District 6 and District 11. Door hangers and signs at the villa entries will be placed in all areas that will be impacted by this work. Please check the signs at your villa entry for application dates, as well as changes due to unforeseen circumstances.

This work began on March 12, 2018 and is scheduled to be complete on March 23, 2018. Please understand that these dates may change due to equipment issues, rain delays or irrigation not being turned off. It is extremely important that you do not run your irrigation or do any car washing the day before, the day of and the day after application. 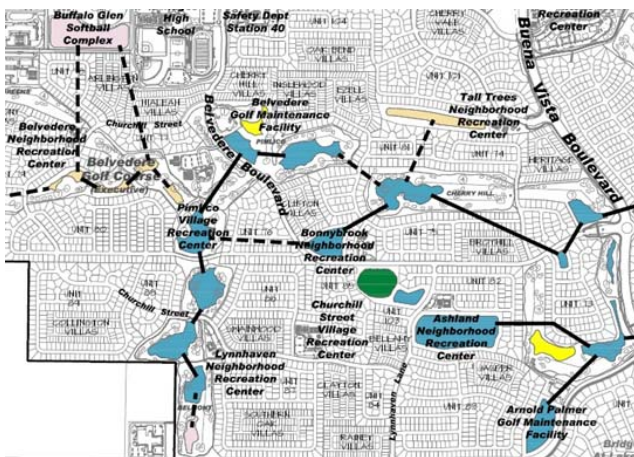

Did you know that many of the water retention areas in our community are connected through various inlets and pipes? In addition to storm water, everything that enters the storm water pipes can end up in the water retention areas throughout our community. This includes trash, leaves, fertilizer, soap from washing vehicles, animal droppings and more.

Please help us ensure the health and continued maintenance of the water retention basins throughout The Villages by not placing **ANYTHING** in any of the storm water drains. Our National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit does not allow dumping into these storm drain systems.

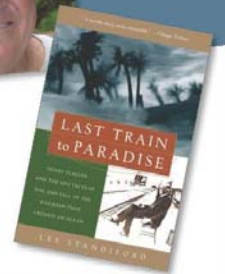
