The following facilities will be closed or have scheduled maintenance:

⇒ Amberwood Executive Golf Course

The Amberwood Executive Golf Course will be closed April 23rd and will remain closed for approximately 2 weeks. This closure will allow the course to transition from cool season grasses to the native Bermuda grass.

⇒ Hawkes Bay Executive Golf Course

The Hawkes Bay Executive Golf Course will be closed for approximately five (5) months for a full course renovation. The work that will be completed includes the resurfacing of greens and tees and it is scheduled to begin Monday, May 7, 2018.




