Area 1—Scheduled to re-open on May 9th.



Are you ready for that outdoor living space with an in ground pool and birdcage? If the answer is yes, the Community Standards Department will guide you through the process of achieving architectural approval. Architectural Review Committee (ARC) approval is required prior to **any external modification** / **alteration** being done to the outside of your home / homesite.

Why is an ARC application required? The District's adopted Rule to enforce certain external deed restrictions and have architectural oversight states that no reconstruction, additions, alterations or modifications to the home / homesite will be permitted without prior written consent of the ARC. The mission of the Architectural Review Committee is to assist in maintaining the high quality and consistency of the aesthetic beauty and design of residences and home sites found throughout The Villages.

The application is easy to complete but if you need assistance, the Community Standards Department hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and any staff member would be happy to sit down with you and assist you through the application process.
