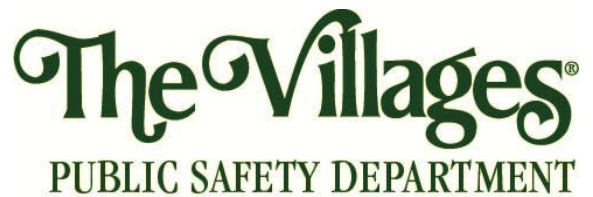

Do You Know?

Do you know how many lightning flashes there are in the state of Florida each year?? The average number of lightning flashes in Florida each year is 1,170,979!

This week is Lightning Awareness Week and there are several resources available to learn more about lightning safety! The following information is provided by The National Weather Service.

*There is no safe place outside when thunderstorms are in the area. If you hear thunder, you are likely within striking distance of the storm. Just remember, **When Thunder Roars, Go Indoors.** Too many people wait far too long to get to a safe place when thunderstorms approach. Unfortunately, these delayed actions lead to many of the lightning deaths and injuries in the United States.*

Did You Know??

Fences and Railings

Fences and railings are permitted with stipulations on certain types of homes.

HOME UNITS:

Fences may be used to screen condenser/compressor units, pool pumps and related equipment and shall be no higher than the unit(s) itself.

Railings or fences are permitted around patio slabs so long as they are wrought iron, aluminum, plastic, concrete or any other aesthetically pleasing material no higher than 48 inches at its highest point.

Railings or fences are permitted across the front of the home and/or abutting the front walkway so long as they are wrought iron, aluminum, plastic, concrete or any other aesthetically pleasing material no higher than 48 inches at its highest point.

No other fences or railings are permitted.

Railings or fences are not permitted on either side lengthwise of the driveways.

COURTYARD VILLA:

No fences or railings are permitted on the front of the courtyard villas.

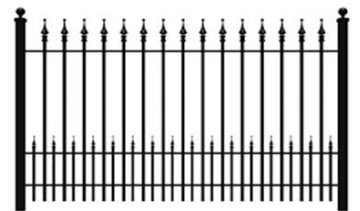
Railings or fences are permitted around patio slabs so long as they are wrought iron, aluminum, plastic, concrete or any other aesthetically pleasing material no higher than 48 inches at its highest point.

Fences may be used to screen condenser/compressor units, pool pumps and related equipment and shall be no higher than the unit(s) itself.

PATIO VILLA:

Other than originally constructed, fences and railings are prohibited.
