September / October Turf Talk

On Sunday, September 23rd, the calendar says it will be the first day of fall. In these exciting upcoming 2 months, our golf management community will be preparing for the busy season of winter play.

As our golf maintenance contractors prepare the courses, the District Executive Golf Team is planning the opening of many new additions after various improvements that occurred over the summer months.

Some highlights of these planned openings near the end of September and into October include the recently renovated tee, green and bunker complexes at the Hawks Bay Executive Golf Course. The new Practice Green/Tee complex at Silver Lake, the bunker capping of Oakleigh/Amberwood and the complete installation of new cart paths for Silver Lake and Chula Vista all make for an exciting two months in store for our residents!

Please remember that the courses will have a single day closure scheduled for over seed, as well as several blocked tee times throughout the upcoming weeks for over seed, irrigation and establishment. These closures will ensure superintendents complete the proper amounts of seeding on all tees. October should be unique this year as well. After 10 to 14 days with proper weather, the over seed should be fully established. As a result, your playing conditions should be ideal throughout the winter months.

What to bring

- Automotive fluids
- Automotive batteries
- Cleaners
 - Fertilizers
 - Fluorescent lamps and Mercury containing devices
 - Fungicides
 - Wood preservatives
- Herbicides
- · Rechargeable household batteries
- Household electronics (TVs, VCRs, computers, etc.)
- Latex & oil based paints
- Paint removers
- Paint thinners
- Pesticides
- · Pool chemicals
- Solvents
- Smoke detectors
- Propane tanks (25lbs)





What not to bring

- · Biological/Infectious waste
- Explosives
- · Radioactive waste
- Empty paint cans

HOW TO PACKAGE AND TRANSPORT CHEMICALS

- Do NOT mix chemicals together.
- Keep products in original labeled containers if possible.
- Place containers into cardboard boxes to prevent breakage.
- (4) Place leaky container in clear plastic bag and transport in box with newspaper.
- (5) Put boxes in trunk or in back of vehicle away from passengers.
