HAPPY NEW YEAR

On Monday, October 1st, the District celebrates the start of the new Fiscal Year 2018 -19! The budgets for the 15 independent districts were approved at the September Board meetings in accordance to Florida State Statutes. The one dependent district submitted their proposed budget to the Sumter County Board of Commissioners which approved the final budget in July.

Thanks to the Budget team which includes 82 Board Supervisors, 2 Committees, District staff who worked hard in the preparation of the budget. Thanks also to the residents who took time out of their busy Villages lifestyle to provide input and attend budget workshops/board meetings.

Did you know...if we add the approved budgets for the 53 Funds in the 16 Districts then the total FY2018-19 Budget is \$354,558,742!

The Budget information is posted on the District's website – www.Districtgov.org for all 16 Districts. To view the Budget information please click on your district, click on the Budget link under Quick Links on the left-hand side then click on the FY18-19 Adopted Budget link. Be sure to check out the budget information which includes line-item budgets and the maintenance assessment schedules that provide the maintenance assessments rates by unit. This year there were only three districts, Districts 2, 3 and 4, that had overall increases to their maintenance assessment rates. The approved budgets reflect the District's commitment to continued enhancements of customer service, operational transparency and efficiency as outlined within the District's recent reorganization.
