The Manatee Recreation Center will be closed for cleaning on December 8th.



Village Community Development Districts 1-11

There will not be sanitation collection on Tuesday, January 1, 2019. For those with Tuesday trash and/or recycling, collection will occur on **Saturday**, **December 29th.** Please have your bags out no later than 6:00 a.m. All others will follow your normal collection schedule.

If your sanitation collection is serviced by Waste Management in the Villages of Fenney, DeSota, and McClure, you will not have sanitation collection service on Tuesday, December 25th or Tuesday, January 1st. Collection will occur on your next normally scheduled collection day.

If you live in the Lady Lake portion of The Villages, please contact Waste Management at (352) 787-4416 for additional information.





The Villages Public Safety Department will begin our Fire Hydrant Flush and Inspections program this week. Hydrant flush and inspections are required for ISO (Insurance Services Office) and the Hydrant Policy. Hydrant inspection affords crews the familiarity with all the hydrants in their response area. We currently have 4202 hydrants. The hydrants are located in and around The Villages Fire Service area. This task will take our firefighters approximately one month to complete. They will flush all hydrants until the water quality is clear and report all deficits to our fire prevention division, so repairs can be addressed by the respected water purveyor.

Fireworks are often used to mark special events and holidays. However, they are not safe in the hands of consumers. Fireworks cause thousands of burns and eye injuries each year. People can enjoy fireworks safely if they follow a few simple safety tips:

Sparklers


BE CAREFUL!

- Be safe. If you want to see fireworks, go to a public show put on by experts.
- Do not use consumer fireworks.
- Keep a close eye on children at events where fireworks are used.

CONSUMER FIREWORKS

NFPA is opposed to consumer use of fireworks. This includes sparklers and firecrackers. Even sparklers burn hot enough to cause third-degree burns.

FACTS

- Pireworks cause an average of almost 18,500 reported fires per year.
- Sparklers account for roughly one-quarter of emergency room fireworks injuries.
