Your Executive Golf department has been working diligently to keep the momentum going with all the course improvements and tee over seed projects this fall and now into winter.

The Thanksgiving Holiday passed and we have seen a consistent improvement in playing conditions.

During the month of December, we will be implementing the bi weekly golf course closure schedule. The success we achieved last year with this program will continue for the month. These short closures will allow the contractors to do the extra necessary maintenance due diligence to help maintain quality conditions throughout the winter and into the spring.

Your golf course superintendents and their management teams will be performing work and utilizing resources to accomplish work that normally can not be completed in the summer. This includes tree trimming, bed cleaning, landscape additions and many more projects.

Please remember with these cooler months, even here in Florida, we experience **frost delays**. Luckily, frost delays have not been implemented so far this year and we are thankful for this. Please be aware when we do have frost delays on courses, it is strictly to protect the plants from desiccation and permanent damage caused by golf traffic.

Remaining off the playing surface is extremely important during these delays. Please be patient and wait for your starters to give the all clear before proceeding onto any turf surfaces. It is also important to avoid leaving the path until temperatures are about 38 degrees.

TURF TIP:

<u>Frost Delay and turf</u>. This is caused by micro climates at leaf level falling around 32 degrees.

These cold temperatures are enough to cause cell walls in plant tissue to become brittle and break. This kills the leaf by disturbing the natural flow of nutrients and photosynthesis process.

Frost Delays are used to stop traffic from breaking plant leaves until thawing can occur.

Safety Reminders for the Holidays

Community Watch will be working around the clock throughout the holidays. We will be at full staffing levels in all phases of our operation: patrol, gate attendants, dispatch and gate ops.

A couple of safety reminders:

- If you will be away for the holidays, Community Watch offers a house check program for your consideration. For a small fee, a CW patrol driver will walk the perimeter of your home 3 times per week. If anything is not as it should be, we will contact you, your neighbor, or law enforcement if necessary. At the very least, have a neighbor keep an eye on your home while you are away.
- Indoor lights on timers are a great way to give the impression that someone is home.
- Cancel paper delivers or have your neighbor pick up your papers from the driveway.
- Track the delivery of your packages to be delivered to your home. Don't leave your packages sitting on your front doorstep for very long.

If you are having guests for the holidays that may be unfamiliar with The Villages, let them know that they can get assistance in the form of "word map directions" from any of our manned gates. Del Mar Gate Operation Changes

Based on direction from the Amenity Authority Committee (AAC) at the November 2018 meeting, residents will begin to see operational changes at the Del Mar gate during the week of December 17, 2018 to improve the overall functionality of the gate. Some of the changes you may begin to see include:

- <u>December 19, 2018 through January 6, 2019</u> the gate will operate as a "visitor lane" style gate in which the Gate Attendant will open the gate for all users. The Gate Attendant will NOT use a hand held stop sign or be stationed on the sidewalk near the roadway. The gate arm activation switch is located in the gatehouse where the attendant will be located. The Gate Attendant will have discretion to lock the gate in the "up" position during heavy traffic, as necessary.
- <u>January 7, 2019 through January 26, 2019</u> the gate will be operated in "automatic open mode". The Gate Attendant will be stationed in the doorway to provide customer service and greet users. As users approach the gate, the arm will automatically open WITHOUT the use of a gate access card or push of the button. The Gate Attendant will have the discretion to lock the gate in the "up" position during heavy traffic, as necessary.

We appreciate your patience as we attempt to improve the functionality and customer service provided at the Del Mar Gate. Please use caution and reduce your speed when approaching the gate and pay attention to all directions provided by the Gate Attendant.
