If you live in the Lady Lake portion of The Villages, please contact Waste Management at (352) 787-4416 for additional information.



Obey all traffic laws.
If no sidewalks are present, walk against the direction of traffic so you can see oncoming vehicles.

Always use the crosswalk.
Push the button to get the walk signal.

Be visible. Wear bright, reflective colors on your clothes, shoes, belts and wristbands.



Avoid distractions while driving. Focus on the road.

Pass bicyclists safely.
Allow at least three feet
between your vehicle
and the bicyclist.

Slow down! Speed is the cause of 32% of all fatal crashes.



Always wear a helmet.
Ride in the same
direction of traffic on
the street. Obey all
traffic signs, signals,
and lane markings.

Yield to traffic when appropriate. It's better to yield than "be in the right" and risk injury.

Be visible. Position yourself in the lane so others can easily see you. Always use a headlight and taillight at night.

Del Mar Gate Operation Changes

Based on direction from the Amenity Authority Committee (AAC) at the November 2018 meeting, residents will begin to see operational changes at the Del Mar gate during the week of December 17, 2018 to improve the overall functionality of the gate. Some of the changes you may begin to see include:

- <u>December 19, 2018 through January 6, 2019</u> the gate will operate as a "visitor lane" style gate in which the Gate Attendant will open the gate for all users. The Gate Attendant will NOT use a hand held stop sign or be stationed on the sidewalk near the roadway. The gate arm activation switch is located in the gatehouse where the attendant will be located. The Gate Attendant will have discretion to lock the gate in the "up" position during heavy traffic, as necessary.
- <u>January 7, 2019 through January 26, 2019</u> the gate will be operated in "automatic open mode". The Gate Attendant will be stationed in the doorway to provide customer service and greet users. As users approach the gate, the arm will automatically open WITHOUT the use of a gate access card or push of the button. The Gate Attendant will have the discretion to lock the gate in the "up" position during heavy traffic, as necessary.

We appreciate your patience as we attempt to improve the functionality and customer service provided at the Del Mar Gate. Please use caution and reduce your speed when approaching the gate and pay attention to all directions provided by the Gate Attendant.
