

Did you know The District has a Risk Management Department that performs a multitude of services to enhance the lifestyle in The Villages?

### **Risk Management Function**

The primary function of the department is to identify, evaluate, and control the District's exposure to loss or damage to physical assets.

### **Risk Management Responsibilities**

- Review damages to District property, including gates, by investigating each incident, determining responsible parties, and working to recover losses.
- Review all Third Party Incident Reports occurring on District property.
- Track and monitor pending and litigated claims.
- Act as liaison with outside contractors in coordinating all matters regarding the District's property and liability insurance.
- Review District insurance needs annually and procure packages that fulfill needs while maximizing value.
- Coordinate the District's employee safety program including facilitation of Safety Committee.
- Mitigate risk to employees and public.

### Adopt-A-Bench

- Take unwanted paints, yard chemicals and automotive fluids to a local Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center or Event.
- Clean up after your pet by disposing waste in an approved receptacle.
- Dechlorinate swimming pool water prior to discharge.
- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean your driveway. Keep leaves, grass clippings and trash away from the storm drain.

Preventative maintenance is occurring on the potable water system field valves throughout many areas of The Villages. Those customers serviced by Village Center Service Area (VCSA), Little Sumter Service Area (LSSA) and North Sumter Utilities (NSU) that will be impacted will be notified 24 hours in advance of a temporary interruption in service and will receive the following notification:

THE PUBLIC DRINKING WATER MAINS IN YOUR AREA WILL BE SHUT DOWN TEMPORARILY FOR NEEDED MAINTENANCE.

AS A PRECAUTION, UPON RETURN OF WATER SERVICE, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR **DRINKING, MAKING ICE, AND COOKING BE BOILED, FOR ALL OTHER HOUSE HOLD USES THE WATER IS ACCEPTABLE**. A ROLLING BOIL OF ONE MINUTE IS SUFFICIENT. AS AN ALTERNATIVE, BOTTLED WATER MAY BE USED.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE MAINTENANCE TASK HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS, YOU MAY CONTACT DEANNA SIMMONS, FROM THE WATER DEPARTMENT AT (352) 259-2802 (NSU WWTP).

Sumter County Announces Roadway Improvement Project Along C-466 And CR-101

The Villages, FL -

To improve the safety and traffic flow for the traveling public, Sumter County has initiated a roadway improvement project along C-466 and CR-101. Construction will commence the week of February 25, 2019, and end before the first week of May 2019. Given the location of the construction, lane closures will be utilized between the hours of 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM.

There are five separate work locations for this project. Project location 1 is the eastbound left turn lane on C-466 at CR-105. Work at this location will include milling, resurfacing, installing thermoplastic pavement markings, and raised pavement markings (RPM's). Project location 2 is the eastbound left turn lane on C-466 at CR-103. Project location 3 is the eastbound left turn lane on C-466 at CR-101. Project location 4 is the eastbound left turn lane on C-466 at Buena Vista Blvd. Project location 2, 3, 4 will extend the eastbound left-turn lanes approximately 110 feet, 210 feet, and 200 feet respectively. Project location 5 will add a directional median opening on CR 101 at Wedgewood Lane.

Please use caution when traveling C-466 and CR-101 during our construction progress. Partial lane closures are to be expected, and heavy machinery will be working near the travel way. Please travel at the posted construction speed limit to protect yourselves and construction workers.
