Aquatic Pool Lifts

The District owns and maintains close to 90 pools throughout The Villages community. District Property Management (DPM) is currently in the process of installing 42 new ADA accessible pool lifts within the community over the next 24 months as directed by the District Boards. Currently the installation work is focused on eight (8) new pool lift installations at the pools north of C-466 approved by the Amenity Authority Committee (AAC) and Village Center Community Development District (VCCDD). Once these are completed (by September 2019 based on the current schedule), the work to install thirty-four (34) pool lifts will commence South of C-466 as approved by the Project Wide Advisory Committee (PWAC) and Sumter Landing Community Development District (SLCDD). When the project is complete, all District pools will have an aquatic access pool lift. As with all the work that DPM performs, unfortunately there are times when the need to complete necessary work creates inconveniences for residents. To maintain all the pools at a high level of service and install new equipment, pool closures are necessary at times to expedite completion of the work (limiting overall impact) and to protect the residents from the hazards of performing the work. Our installation schedule for each of these lifts is typically 3-5 working days; however, in some circumstances where there are unexpected issues in the execution of the work, schedules may be impacted. In our schedule, DPM will attempt not to close pools over the weekend unless not doing so would create a public safety risk. Public notice of closures will be posted on www.DistrictGov.org prior to the work being performed. DPM will do it's best to communicate unexpected changes to the schedule in

The Villages Community Development Districts Property Management

District Property Management (DPM) maintains many District owned assets including the multi-modal paths within the District. DPM is currently in the process of managing a project approved by the District Boards to upgrade the wayfinding/directional signage on the multi-modal trail to install new retroreflective sign panels on decorative posts to help guide residents in their use of the path system. This signage is for guidance to key multi-modal paths, key recreation centers and at major decision points at tunnel stop sign motorist decision points. The new sign panels are compliant with the lettering font and size as specified within the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). The first phase of the project is near completion as the majority of the new sign poles have been installed. In the next phase of the project which will occur over the next 30 days, the contractor will be installing the new sign panels on each of the new poles. As they install the new signs, they will be removing the old signs and restoring the landscaping to provide a quality finished product. Please use care when traveling the paths to help protect our staff and contractor as they work to complete this beneficial project. Rainey Construction Company is tentatively scheduled to begin resurfacing the following villa roads. Dates may be adjusted due to unforeseen circumstances, including weather.

Everything possible will be done to minimize your inconvenience. For the SAFETY of our crews and all residents, we ask that you reschedule any work or deliveries to your Villa until the paving is complete as they may be denied access. Only residents and emergency vehicles will have immediate access during the construction.

PLEASE DO NOT run your irrigation, wash your vehicle or empty your pool during the week, as it will increase the work time.

ALL vehicles and trailers must be parked OFF of the roads and the overflow parking areas must be empty, as to not impede the work.

Please be advised that newly paved roadways will take approximately one hour to cure and should not be driven on while hot! Driving before this time could result in tracking asphalt onto your driveway and damaging the new roadway.

If you must travel through the construction, PLEASE drive slowly and watch for and listen to directions provided by the contract workers.

Our goal is to give you a new road that will last a maximum life with the LEAST amount of inconvenience. Your cooperation is GREATLY APPRECIATED. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS RESIDING IN DISTRICT 12

As part of the City of Wildwood's and the privately owned South Sumter Utility Company's (Utility) potable water system maintenance program, the Utility has contracted with Jacobs/CH2M to develop and implement a Unidirectional Flushing (UDF) Program for all areas of The Villages south of SR 44. UDF programs are commonly used across North America to improve operations, enhance the water system and improve service standards. One of the goals of this program is to help alleviate some of the discolored water issues that have been intermittently experienced. An additional goal is to help prepare the potable water system for a change in water source. During the month of July, the water source for The Villages south of SR 44 will transition to the new Water Treatment Plant (WTP) that is being constructed near the intersection of CR 468 and the Turnpike.

The UDF Program began during the week of May 28th and is anticipated to continue for approximately 5 to 6 weeks in order for all areas of the potable water system to be addressed. The duration for each area being flushed is anticipated to be approximately 2 to 4 days and will occur during weekdays between the hours of 7 am and 6 pm. Immediately prior to the beginning of UDF activities in each area, door hanger notices will be placed at each residence or commercial facility.

Preventative maintenance is occurring on the potable water system field valves throughout many areas of The Villages. Those customers serviced by Village Center Service Area (VCSA), Little Sumter Service Area (LSSA) and North Sumter Utilities (NSU) that will be impacted will be notified 24 hours in advance of a temporary interruption in service and will receive the following notification:

THE PUBLIC DRINKING WATER MAINS IN YOUR AREA WILL BE SHUT DOWN TEMPORARILY FOR NEEDED MAINTENANCE.

AS A PRECAUTION, UPON RETURN OF WATER SERVICE, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR **DRINKING, MAKING ICE, AND COOKING BE BOILED, FOR ALL OTHER HOUSE HOLD USES THE WATER IS ACCEPTABLE**. A ROLLING BOIL OF ONE MINUTE IS SUFFICIENT. AS AN ALTERNATIVE, BOTTLED WATER MAY BE USED.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE MAINTENANCE TASK HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK.
