

## What's Happening in Your District

## **Public Hearings**

Districts 5 and 6 will be holding Public Hearings to discuss Amending and Restating the Chapter II Rule to Bring about Deed Compliance, specifically for:

- Providing for reimbursement of attorneys' fees incurred by the District in
  enforcing its Rules and the deed restrictions, and for the recording of the Order
  of Enforcement in the Public Records of Sumter County, Florida, once entered by
  the District, so that the Order of Enforcement acts as a lien against the violator's
  real property.
- Pressure Washing and Hedge Trimming If a property is found in non-compliance of the Rule's pressure washing and/or hedge/shrubbery trimming requirement, the Board may at the respective public hearing order maintenance of the property to bring the property into compliance with the District's Rule. Such maintenance may include: (a) pressure washing a home, driveway, walkway, fences, or walls; and/or (b) trimming hedges and shrubbery off the soffit and/or rain gutters of the home, and entry to the front door. The cost of any such maintenance shall be borne by and charged to the property owner and shall include the actual cost of maintenance plus an administrative fee in accordance with the Fine Schedule.

The Public Hearing for District 5 will be held at the SeaBreeze Recreation Complex on July 15, 2022, at 8:00 AM.

Hurricane season is well underway. As of July 14, 2022, there have been 3 named tropical storms in the Atlantic Basin this year.

The best thing a person can do is to be prepared for at least one storm per season. You should be personally prepared as well as assisting family and friends with preparations. Preparedness involves your home and your well-being. If you leave the area during the summer, take in all loose lawn items before you go. Wind chimes and bird feeders can become projectiles in inclement weather. These items could damage your house or your neighbor's house.

The Villages

Make sure you have non-perishable food items, water, essential documents, flashlights, a battery back or other means of charging your cell phone, NOAA weather radio, and any supplies needed for your pet. Plan on having enough food, water, and other supplies to last seven (7) days—purchase bottled water instead of 1-gallon jugs. A 24-pack of 16.9 oz bottles equals 3.3 gallons of water. The smaller bottles are easier to handle and reduce the chance of spilling a larger container and losing water. Along with the food items, have a non-electric can opener, paper plates, napkins, plastic cups, and utensils.



Make copies of your important documents: Insurance cards or policies, medical records, bank numbers, a set of house and car keys. Take photos or videos of the interior, exterior, and contents of your home. These items should be kept in a waterproof container.



The State of Florida provides an informative website to help you create a plan for yourself and your loved ones — <u>FloridaDisaster.org/planprepare</u>. This website also has many helpful resources for preparedness.

Lake, Marion, and Sumter counties all have an alerting service. These alerting services are used for emergency notifications. During hurricane season, the counties can send out storm updates to your home phone, cell phones, and emails. These updates will give guidance on the current conditions of the storm.

## Who provides road maintenance in The Villages Community?

As The Villages continues to grow, the various municipal entities which provide maintenance services for the associated roadway infrastructure also grow. Road maintenance in The Villages Community falls under the purview of various governmental entities. If you have concerns pertaining to road maintenance in your area, please contact the appropriate agency below. If you are not sure who to call, please contact District Property Management at 352-753-4022 for assistance.

**Roads located within the Lady Lake/Lake County portion of The Villages:** Lady Lake Public Works - 352-751-1500 or Lake County Road Works - 352-343-6439.

Roads located within District 4 (Marion County) portion of The Villages: District Property Management - 352-753-4022.

Roads (with the exception of villa roads) located within Districts 1-3 and 5-10 in the Sumter County portion of The Villages: Sumter County Public Works - 352-689-4400.

**Roads located within District 11 (Fruitland Park) portion of The Villages:** Fruitland Park Public Works - 352-360-6795.

**Roads located within District 12 and 13 of The Villages:** The vast majority of roads within District 12 are maintained by the City of Wildwood Public Works - 352-330-1343. If appropriate, they will refer the call to Sumter County.

Villa Roads located in Districts 1-3 and 5-11 in the Sumter County & Fruitland Park portion of The Villages: District Property Management - 352-753-4022.



## Lawn Ornaments & Yard Art

#### DISTRICTS THAT PROHIBIT LAWN ORNAMENTS & YARD ART

- District 3 (with the exception of Units 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 42, 43, 608, 609, 610 & 611)
- Districts 4 through 13

## Lawn ornaments & yard art for these Districts may be placed in the following locations:

- Inside the home
- · Inside the lanai
- On the concrete slab located underneath the roof of the front porch (NOT under the eaves of the home)









Lawn ornaments or yard art, generally refers to man-made items located anywhere outside the structure or footprint of the home. However, pots and planters designed and constructed for plant use are permitted if they are used for their intended purpose. The inclusion or attachment of flowers or plants to a man-made ornament, not originally constructed for plant use, does not change the item from a lawn ornament to landscaping. The word "lawn" includes areas that are mulched, concreted, sodded, rocked, landscaped, bare earth or any other material outside the structure (footprint) of the home. The following is intended as a partial reference list of lawn ornaments: any man-made concrete, resin, ceramic statue or figure including windmills, pinwheels, religious symbols, train sets, animal or human figures.

Lawn ornaments may be placed on the concrete slab located underneath the roof of the front porch. Lawn ornaments are permitted in these locations as they are considered internal areas and the District only has authority to enforce certain external deed restrictions.



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## Frequently Asked Questions and Answers





Is your sewer backing up? Is water flowing out of your yard and down the street? If your answer is yes, call us at 352-750-0000!

The District Utilities Department and their contractor Jacobs are responsible for maintaining the water and sewer mains that service your home for the majority of areas within The Villages. If you reside in Phillips Villas or Soulliere Villas, please contact Marion County Utilities at 352-307-6000 for sewer issues. For all other residents, please contact the District at 352-750-0000. For water service, the utility provider's responsibility ends at the brass portion of the water meter and the homeowner's responsibility begins at the PVC connection side of the water meter. For sewer service, the utility provider's responsibility ends at the 6" cleanout located in the utility right of way in the front of your home.

If your lights go out, you typically would call the electric company to confirm whether or not there is a problem with their service. For water or sewer issues, many people tend to call a plumber first. Please call us at 352-750-0000 so that we can evaluate our side of the sewer system and determine where the issue is located. If it is found that the issue is on the District side, we will make repairs. If the issue is on the homeowner's side, we will let you know so you can contact a repair provider such as a plumber.

Please note that the District will not evaluate any issues with leaking water inside your home, only sewer issues.

#### WATER SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

Preventative maintenance is occurring on the potable water system field valves throughout many areas of The Villages. Those customers serviced by Village Center Service Area (VCSA), Little Sumter Service Area (LSSA), North Sumter Utilities (NSU), Central Sumter Utilities (CSU) and South Sumter Utilities (SSU) that will be impacted will be notified 24 hours in advance of a temporary interruption in service and will receive the following notification:

THE PUBLIC DRINKING WATER MAINS IN YOUR AREA WILL BE SHUT DOWN TEMPORARILY FOR NEEDED MAINTENANCE. AS A PRECAUTION, UPON RETURN OF WATER SERVICE, WE ADVISE THAT <u>ALL WATER USED</u> FOR DRINKING, MAKING ICE, AND COOKING BE BOILED, FOR ALL OTHER HOUSE HOLD USES THE WATER IS ACCEPTABLE. A ROLLING BOIL OF ONE MINUTE IS SUFFICIENT. AS AN ALTERNATIVE, BOTTLED WATER MAY BE USED.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE MAINTENANCE TASK HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK. THIS USUALLY CONSISTS OF A TWO-DAY SAMPLING PERIOD TO INSURE SAFE DRINKING WATER.
