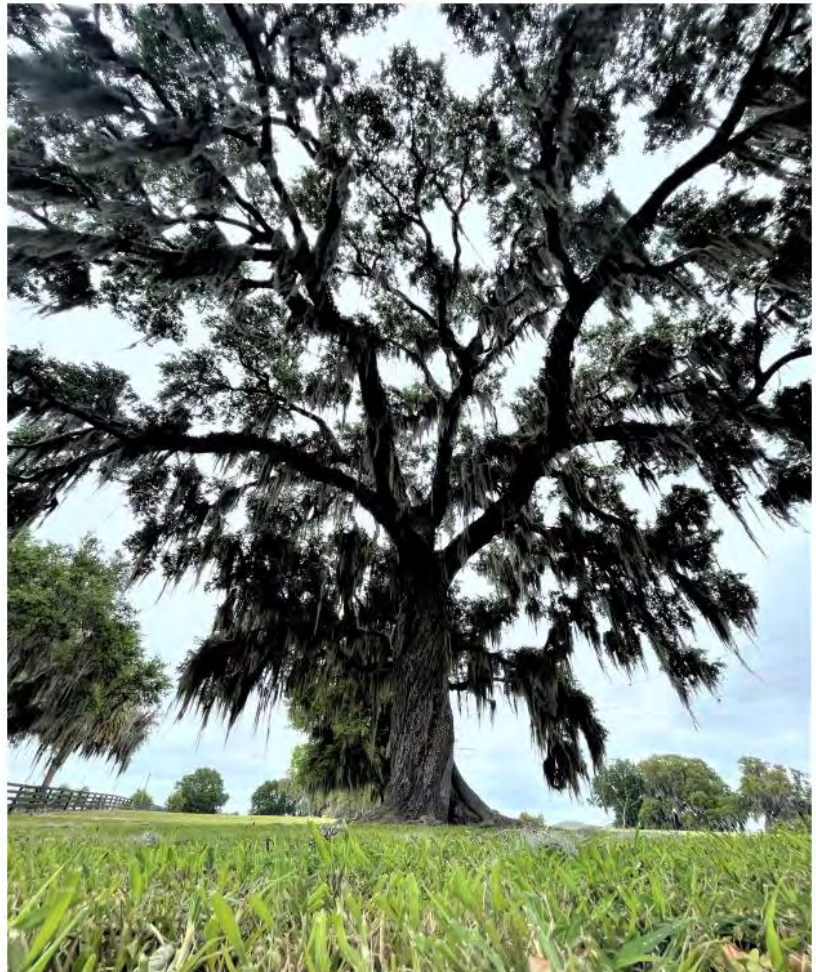

Why is September 16, 2022 an important date in regard to my Bond?

A property owner can pay off their Bond principal balance in full at any time of the year. However, if you pay off your Bond any time from now until 5 PM on September 16, 2022, the payoff amount will be adjusted for the full interest amount to be paid on the November 2022 tax bill.

If you choose to pay your Bond off in full during this time, you will have one last Bond assessment on your November 2022 Property Tax bill. That tax bill must be paid in full.

To obtain a Bond payoff amount or for other questions regarding your Bond, please contact the Bond Office at 352-751-3900. Please call to schedule an appointment prior to visiting the office.

If you are interested in the breakdown of how your Bond is paid, all Bond amortization schedules are available on the District's website at [DistrictGov.org](https://www.districtgov.org). Click on the quick link to Residential Bond Assessment Information.

Please remember that even when the Bond is paid in full, there will continue to be an annual Maintenance Assessment on your County Property Tax bill. The Maintenance Assessment pays for ongoing costs to maintain the infrastructure of your District.

You are not required to prepay your Bond. If you do not choose to pay it off in full at this time, the Bond will continue to be annually assessed on the County Property Tax bill.

External and Internal Deed Compliance FAQ

What is an external deed restriction and who can enforce them?

Deed restrictions are declarations between the Declarant (Developer named in your individual Declaration of Restrictions) and the Property Owner. Who can enforce the external deed restrictions?

- Any property owner of any lot may seek to enforce external restrictions against another property owner.
- The Declarant may seek to enforce external and internal restrictions.
- The Village Community Development Districts through adopted Rule may enforce certain EXTERNAL restrictions that have been adopted by each Board to enforce as authorized by Chapter 190 of Florida Statutes.
- Examples of external deed restriction violations include, but are not limited to, external modifications made without ARC approval, overgrown or dead grass and weeds, and inoperable vehicles.

What is an internal deed restriction and who can enforce them?

Deed restrictions are declarations between the Declarant (Developer named in your individual Declaration of Restrictions) and the Property Owner. Who can enforce the internal deed restrictions?

- Any property owner of any lot may seek to enforce internal restrictions against another property owner.
- The Declarant may seek to enforce internal restrictions.
- Examples of internal deed restriction violations include, but are not limited to, underage children living in the home or running a business from the home.

Why can't the Districts enforce internal deed restrictions?

The Village Community Development Districts through adopted Rule may enforce certain EXTERNAL restrictions that have been adopted by each Board to enforce as authorized by Chapter 190 of Florida Statutes.

How can I submit a concern?

You can report potential violations by contacting the Community Standards Department at 352 751-3912, visiting our office at 984 Old Mill Run, or emailing deedcompliance@districtgov.org.

Once I submit a concern, what happens next?

Once Community Standards receives a complaint about an external violation, the Staff verifies the complaint. If the complaint is verified, the Staff works with the property owner in an attempt to bring the property into compliance. If contact is not made with the Owner, Staff begins the process as adopted by each District Board. If a complaint is received for an internal violation, the complaint is provided to the Declarant.

Did You Know??

What is the Neighborhood AED Program?

By training volunteers, purchasing an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and tying into the 911 system, neighbors can become first responders to rescue fellow neighbors. Each responder would have ReadyAlert paging service. When a cardiac arrest occurs, a call is made to 911. Once the 911 operator determines the nature of the emergency to be a cardiac arrest, the system would dispatch the AED group (in addition to medical personnel) via ReadyAlert. While one or more responders would go immediately to the home, others would go to the AED unit and take it where needed. The AED is stored in a locked cabinet located in the neighborhood and all responders have keys. Currently, there are over 195 AED groups in The Villages community.
