Hacienda Hills Temporary Postal Station

The Hacienda Hills Postal Station will be undergoing renovations and will be closed until further notice. All mail delivery will be relocated to the temporary Postal Facility located in the Hacienda Hills Postal Station parking lot starting on Tuesday, December 6, 2022. Barricades will be placed to restrict access to the Hacienda Hills Postal Station and some surrounding areas. A bulletin board and a District correspondence/amenities box have been placed at the temporary facility and are available for use.



The golf car tunnel under Morse Blvd near Hacienda Hills Country Club will be temporarily closed and traffic will be routed west onto Morse Blvd. Portions of the surrounding multi-modal path will be temporarily closed and traffic will be routed to Morse Blvd as well.

There will be NO disruption to mail delivery. Any mail remaining in the current location will be moved to the temporary Postal Facility. **The hours of operation for collecting your mail at the temporary Postal Facility are Monday – Saturday from 12 PM to 6 PM.**

District Property Management Tunnel Painting Project Update and Scheduled Closures

Over the past two years, District Property Management has been working to complete The Villages Tunnel Painting Project and so far, 26 out of the 34 tunnels have been completed. This project was conceived and developed by the Infrastructure Division of District Property Management with the intention to emit brighter lighting during the daytime hours. The specialty paint which is utilized provides significantly better visibility, improves safety, has outstanding durability and is highly resistant to staining and weathering.

Resident feedback on the tunnels that have been completed thus far has been extremely positive — the tunnels are brighter, safer and look much better overall.



District Property Management is now working to complete the tunnel painting of the 8 remaining tunnels. They have all been pressure washed, dried, and prepared for paint application. Labor shortages have greatly impacted our contractor's ability to perform these during nighttime hours and we have agreed to allow them to paint them during the day to complete this project over the next two weeks.

Each tunnel will be closed for approximately 24 hours to allow for paint application and adequate drying time. The contractor will provide signage and re-direct golf car traffic around the tunnel to alternate routes. We apologize for any inconvenience, but we have determined this to be the best approach in getting this much-needed project completed promptly.

As part of the District's continued commitment to provide our residents with efficient and dependable utility service, the Sanitary Sewer Lining project for Unit 01 located within the Lake County portion of The Villages will commence Tuesday, December 15th. Sewer lining is performed in-place and essentially results in a new pipe being installed inside of the existing pipe with no reduction of capacity. The rehabilitation of the system will improve the sewer system and reduce the potential for leaks.

This project will temporarily impact approximately 87 homes along Aloha Way, Vermont Avenue, Paradise Drive and Owen Drive. All construction is anticipated to be completed within two (2) weeks, ending around January 3, 2023.



While a specific section of sewer pipeline is being lined, the affected residents' sewer connections will be out of service. The contractor will perform work during normal business hours. We ask that affected residents minimize their water use during these hours and please DO NOT shower, bathe, use dishwashers or washing machines during this time. We also ask that affected residents keep all toilet flushing to an absolute minimum. Service will likely be restored within 4 – 8 hours or by end of each day. All affected residents will receive at least 24-hour notice of their scheduled outage via door hangers.

The safety of our residents and construction personnel is of the utmost importance. We are requesting everyone to abide by all barricades and warning signs and to avoid the active construction areas for anything other than access to your property. 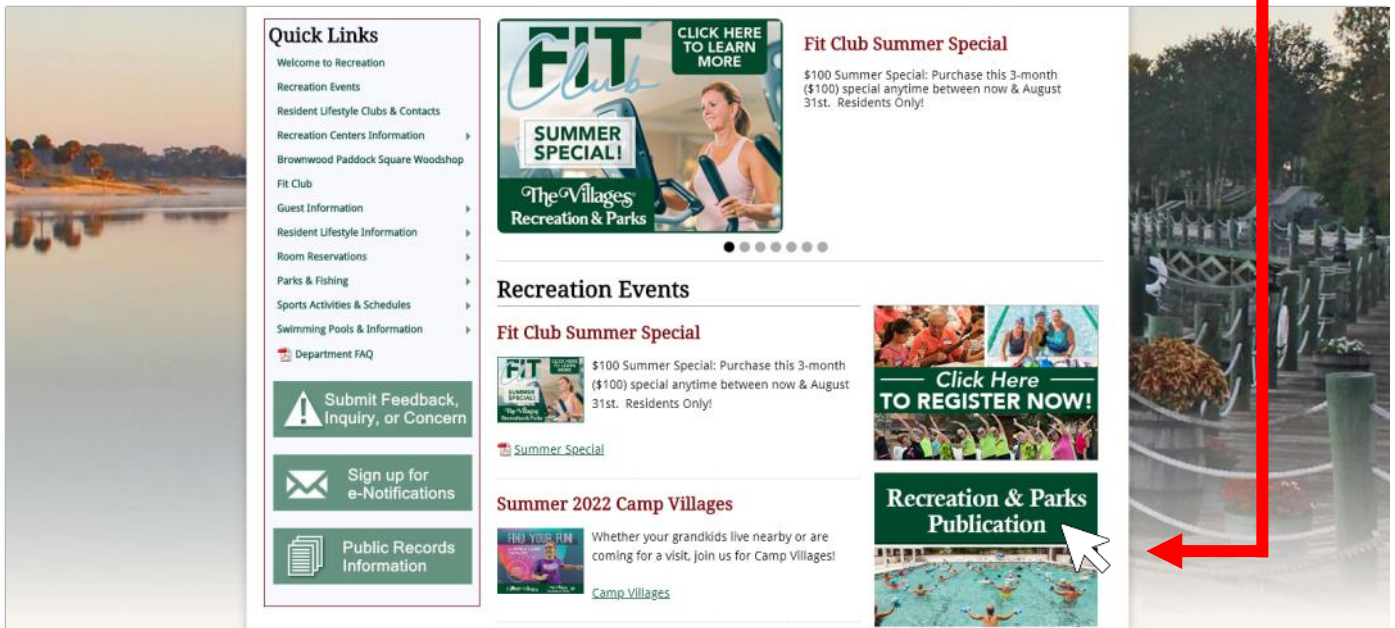

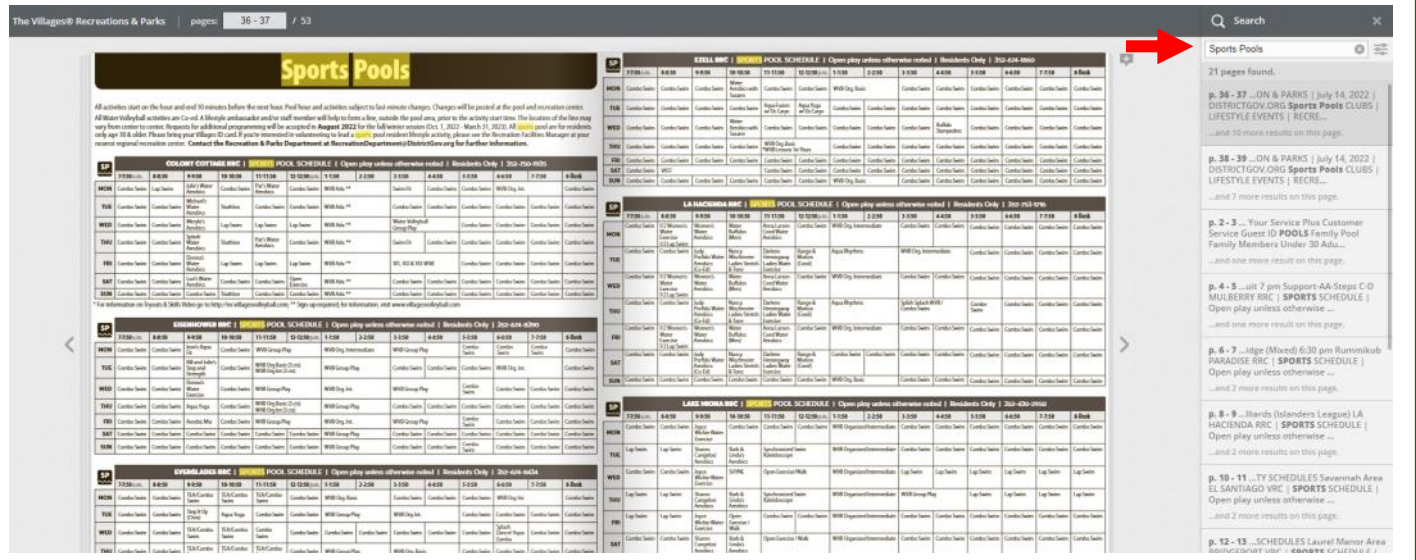

GOLF CAR RULES OF THE ROAD AND SAFETY TIPS

When traveling in a golf car through The Villages Community on a roadway or multi-modal path, we urge you to follow these rules of the road and safety tips to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone. The multi-modal paths are designated for use by non-automotive, non-vehicular traffic such as bicycles, golf cars and pedestrians.

Slow Down and Enjoy The Ride!

BEFORE YOU DRIVE

- Make sure the horn, brakes and lights work.
- Check back-up alarm, tire pressure and applicable gauges.
- Before backing up, look behind and see that all is clear.

RULES OF THE ROAD

- Must be 14 years or older to drive a golf car per Florida State Law, check with your local government jurisdiction for rules
- Drive on neighborhood streets, marked roadside lanes, and multi-modal paths
- Obey all traffic laws, signs and signals
- Golf cars are subject to Florida's open alcoholic container laws
- Speed not to exceed 20mph
- Use hand and turn signals
- Yield to automobiles
- Come to a full stop at stop signs
- Never enter a roundabout in a golf car
- Golf cars are prohibited from roadways with posted speeds of 35mph or more

SAFETY TIPS

- Provide a seat for each person/pet
- Secure all children and pets
- Keep passengers seated in golf car at all times
- Keep arms and legs inside golf car at all times
- Enter traffic lane safely before turning left
- Be aware of vehicles turning right (across the golf car lane)
- Maintain golf car according to manufacturer's recommendations
- Do not text/phone while driving
- Limit passing slower golf cars
- Pull off the path when you need to stop

Safety Reminders for the Holidays

Community Watch will be working around the clock throughout the holidays. We will have staffing in all phases of our operation: Patrol, Gate Attendants, Dispatch and Gate Operations.

A couple of safety reminders:

- Indoor lights on timers are a great way to give the impression that someone is home.
- Cancel paper delivers or have your neighbor pick up your papers from the driveway.
- Track the delivery of your packages to be delivered to your home. Don't leave your packages sitting on your front doorstep for very long.
- If you will be away for the holidays, Community Watch offers a house check program available to all residents leaving the area for more than seven days. Our Patrol Drivers will inspect the exterior only of the home on foot three times a week. They will check for broken windows, any doors/windows that are open or unlocked and any packages/flyers/papers that were left at the front door. If anything is not as it should be, we will contact you, your neighbor or law enforcement if necessary. The cost for this program is \$5.35 a week. You can sign up for this program at the Customer Service Office located at 984 Old Mill Run in Lake Sumter Landing or the Customer Service Satellite Office at 4856 South Morse. At the very least, have a neighbor keep an eye on your home while you are away.

If you are having guests for the holidays that may be unfamiliar with The Villages, let them know that they can get assistance in the form of word map directions from any of our staffed gates. The Gate Attendants also provide word map directions to neighborhoods with unstaffed gates. For additional information, contact Community Watch at 352-753-0550.



Christmas Tree Safety



As you deck the halls this holiday season, be fire smart. A small fire that spreads to a Christmas tree can grow large very quickly.



PICKING THE TREE

- Choose a tree with fresh, green needles that do not fall off when touched.



PLACING THE TREE

- Before placing the tree in the stand, cut 2" from the base of the trunk.
- Make sure the tree is at least three feet away from any heat source, like fireplaces, radiators, candles, heat vents or lights.
- Make sure the tree is not blocking an exit.
- Add water to the tree stand. Be sure to add water daily.



LIGHTING THE TREE

- Use lights that are listed by a qualified testing laboratory. Some lights are only for indoor or outdoor use.
- Replace any string of lights with worn or broken cords or loose bulb connections. Read manufacturer's instructions for number of light strands to connect.
- Never use lit candles to decorate the tree.
- Always turn off Christmas tree lights before leaving home or going to bed.



After Christmas

Get rid of the tree after Christmas or when it is dry. Dried-out trees are a fire danger and should not be left in the home or garage, or placed outside against the home.

Check with your local community to find a recycling program.

Bring outdoor electrical lights inside after the holidays to prevent hazards and make them last longer.

FACTS

- ! **Almost one third** of home Christmas tree fires are caused by electrical problems.
- ! Although Christmas tree fires are not common, when they do occur, they are more likely to be serious.
- ! A heat source too close to the tree causes more than **one in every five** of the fires.
