If you live in the **Lake County portion of The Villages** (not including Districts 11 or 14), there will be no sanitation collection on Tuesday, July 4, 2023. Tuesday collection will be on Wednesday, July 5, 2023. All collection days for the week will be moved to the next day.

If they are under 19 years of age, they must be accompanied by a Villages resident or a Villages guest 19 or over with a valid Guest ID card and photo ID when they are using a Villages recreation facility.

Recreation activities end at 6 PM and centers close at 9 PM on July 4th.

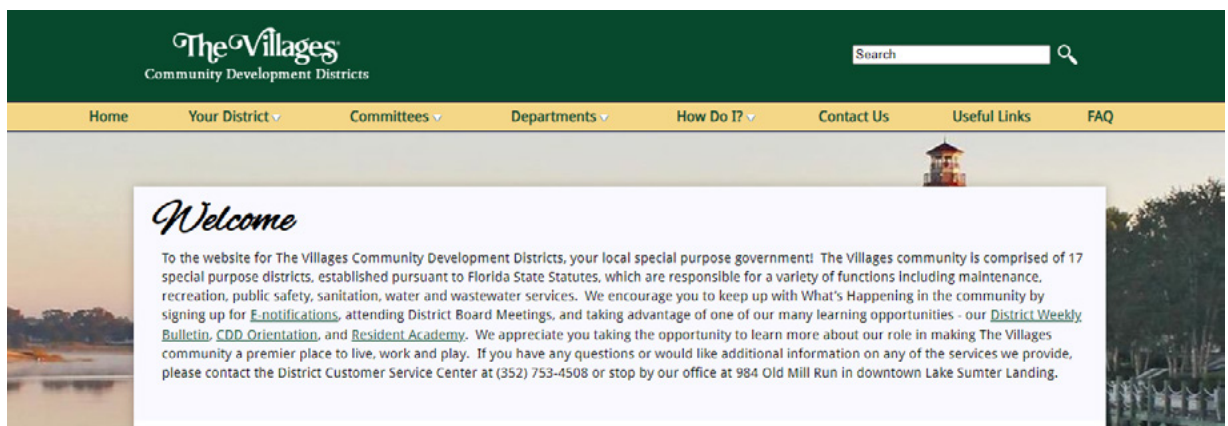

How Do I Order a Guest Pass Online?

Guest Passes can be ordered online to pickup at any At Your Service Center or one of the District Customer Service Centers.

- 1 To order a Guest Pass online, go to DistrictGov.org.



- 2 In the Quick Links menu on the left-hand side of the page, click on "Guest ID Card Service."

How Do I Order a Guest Pass Online?

- 3 Type your Resident ID and Pin Number, then click Log In. Your Resident ID number can be found on your Resident ID card under the barcode. If you don't know your 4 digit pin number, contact the District Customer Service Office at 352-753-4508.

- 4 On the Guest ID Application page — complete the form, select the Pick Up Location, and click Save Application. Complete the information for any other guests.

If you don't have 3 days from the arrival date, once you complete the application, contact the pick up location and they can edit the dates.

Important Bond Payoff Date

› July 14th



This year's Bond cut-off date is July 14, 2023 which is an important date for any resident who would like to pay off their Bond in full. If the Bond is paid off in full by 5:00 PM on July 14, 2023, the bond assessment will no longer appear on your annual County Property tax bill. This option allows residents to save on future interest payments.

Payments must be received in our office by 5:00 PM on July 14, 2023 in order for timely processing.

Payments can be made in person by scheduling an appointment at the District Customer Service Center or by mail to District Customer Service at 984 Old Mill Run, The Villages, FL 32162.

If mailing in your payment, please mail it early to allow extra time for your payment to reach our office.

If you opt not to pay off your Bond in full, you will continue to pay in annual installments. If you have any questions, please contact the Bond Team by email at bonds@districtgov.org or by phone at 352-751-3900.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM FLUSHING: DISTRICTS 5-8

In April 2023, our Utilities Operations and Maintenance contractor (Jacobs) began flushing the Villages Water Conservation Authority (VWCA) irrigation system located in Districts 5-8. Flushing prevents the accumulation of small particles and build-up, which can lead to plugging issues in our irrigation system. Due to the size of the VWCA system, the area has been divided into 90 distinct flushing zones. Once started, this project will take approximately 50 weeks to work through all 90 zones.



As the flushing takes place, you will see the Jacobs team opening fire hydrants and flushing irrigation lines only into the roadway. Work hours will be from 8 am to 5 pm. Information will be updated regularly on the District's website on when you can expect to see the Jacobs team in action in your area. This maintenance work will not have any effects on your drinking water quality nor pressure. This is a proactive effort to maintain your irrigation system.

The safety of residents and contractor personnel is of the utmost importance. We are requesting everyone to abide by all barricades and warning signs and to avoid the active work area for anything other than access to your property.

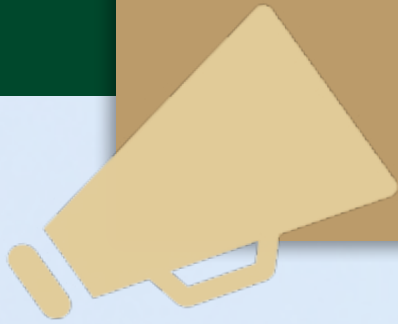
