Swimming Pools

The Recreation & Parks Department strives to make the pools safe for everyone's use and enjoyment! All eligible residents and their guests with valid Guest ID Cards are asked to refrain from:

- Having glass containers inside any pool area.
- Throwing or tossing objects/toys on pool decks or in the pools.
- Playing music too loud - please use headphones or earbuds.
- Smoking within the pool area; designated smoking areas are outside the pool area.

All residents and guests are required to comply with ID requirements and ages to use the swimming pools and supporting amenities and children should have proper approved floatation devices.

Recreation Code of Conduct

Recreation is an integral part of the lifestyle of The Villages community, providing our residents

with outlets for leisure, exercise, socializing and entertainment. So that your programs and activities remain enjoyable for everyone, it is important that we respect our recreation facilities and fellow residents who utilize them.

When using the recreation facilities, we share with you the recreation code of conduct. If any issues arise, we ask that you work towards a resolution, taking advantage of the following mechanisms which are in place to help you with any issues.

- The use of obscenity, profanity or vulgarity in any conversations involving participants or department staff will not be tolerated.
- It is everyone's responsibility to maintain a safe, pleasant, and comfortable playing atmosphere.
- Every individual who participates in any program has the right to be treated with respect. The Golden Rule, "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you," prevails.

› July 14th



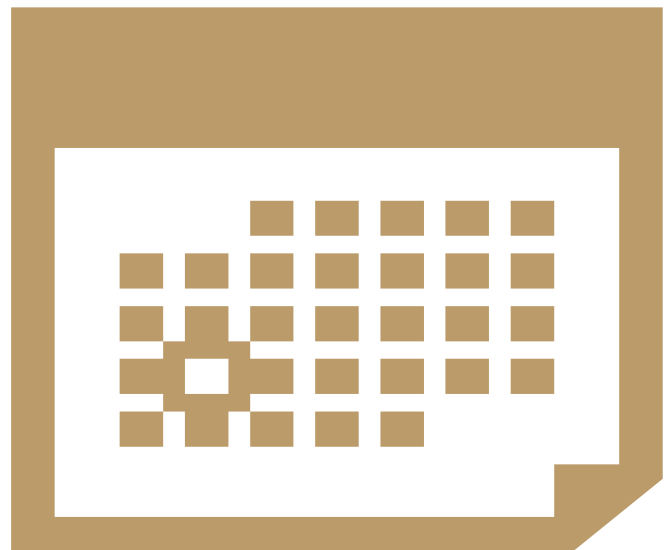
This year's Bond cut-off date is July 14, 2023 which is an important date for any resident who would like to pay off their Bond in full. If the Bond is paid off in full by 5:00 PM on July 14, 2023, the bond assessment will no longer appear on your annual County Property tax bill. This option allows residents to save on future interest payments.

Payments must be received in our office by 5:00 PM on July 14, 2023 in order for timely processing.

Payments can be made in person by scheduling an appointment at any District Customer Service Center or by mail to District Customer Service at 984 Old Mill Run, The Villages, FL 32162.

If mailing in your payment, please mail it early to allow extra time for your payment to reach our office.

GOLF CAR RULES OF THE ROAD AND SAFETY TIPS

When traveling in a golf car through The Villages Community on a roadway or multi-modal path, we urge you to follow these rules of the road and safety tips to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone. The multi-modal paths are designated for use by non-automotive, non-vehicular traffic such as bicycles, golf cars and pedestrians.

Slow Down and Enjoy The Ride!

BEFORE YOU DRIVE

- Make sure the horn, brakes and lights work.
- Check back-up alarm, tire pressure and applicable gauges.
- Before backing up, look behind and see that all is clear.





RULES OF THE ROAD

- Golf car drivers must possess a valid form of government-issued photographic identification
- Drivers under 18 years of age must possess a valid driver's license or learner's driver's license
- Drive on neighborhood streets, marked roadside lanes, and multi-modal paths
- Obey all traffic laws, signs and signals
- Golf cars are subject to Florida's open alcoholic container laws
- Speed not to exceed 20mph
- Use hand and turn signals
- Yield to automobiles
- Come to a full stop at stop signs
- Never enter a roundabout in a golf car
- Golf cars are prohibited from roadways with posted speeds of 35mph or more

SAFETY TIPS

- Provide a seat for each person/pet
- Secure all children and pets
- Keep passengers seated in golf car at all times
- Keep arms and legs inside golf car at all times
- Enter traffic lane safely before turning left
- Be aware of vehicles turning right (across the golf car lane)
- Maintain golf car according to manufacturer's recommendations
- Do not text/phone while driving
- Limit passing slower golf cars
- Pull off the path when you need to stop

Community Watch Programs – Adult Watch



Residents of The Villages can get a sense of reassurance by signing up for the **Community Watch Adult Watch Program**. Participating residents will receive phone calls from Community Watch at designated times during the week to check on their well-being. The Adult Watch Program is a service provided to residents who live alone or have a partner that needs someone to call them for a well-being check. Residents choose the time of the call, as well as how many calls a week they would like.

The Community Watch Communications Center will call the resident, and if there is no answer, they will call again after five minutes. If there is still no answer, Dispatch will send out a Patrol Driver to check on the resident. Simultaneously, local hospitals will be contacted to determine if the resident has been admitted as a patient. If it is confirmed that the resident is not at any local hospital, and the Patrol Driver is still unable to locate the resident, Dispatch will contact the key holders or friends listed

to see if they know the residents whereabouts. If they do not, The Villages Public Safety Department and/or law enforcement will then be notified.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is your sewer backing up? Is water flowing out of your yard and down the street?

If your answer is yes, call us at 352-750-0000!

The District Utilities Department and our contractor Jacobs are responsible for maintaining the water and sewer mains that service your home for the majority of areas within The Villages. If you reside in Phillips Villas or Soulliere Villas, please contact Marion County Utilities at 352-307-6000 for sewer issues. For all other residents, please contact the District at 352-750-0000.

For water service, the utility provider's responsibility ends at the brass portion of the water meter and the homeowner's responsibility begins at the PVC connection side of the water meter. For sewer service, the utility provider's responsibility ends at the 6" cleanout located in the utility right of way in the front of your home.

If your lights go out, you typically would call the electric company to confirm whether or not there is a problem with their service. For water or sewer issues, many people tend to call a plumber first. Please call us at 352-750-0000 so that we can evaluate our side of the sewer system and determine where the issue is located. If it is found that the issue is on the District side, we will make repairs. If the issue is on the homeowner's side, we will let you know so you can contact a repair provider such as a plumber.

Please note that the District will not evaluate any issues with leaking water inside your home, only sewer issues.

Trash Collection Reminders



Bags must be placed for collection before 6 AM on your collection day or no sooner than 5 PM the night before.

All household waste should be placed in sealed tall kitchen trash bags or 20-30 gallon trash bags (any color but red, which is used for medical waste).

The trash bags should be left at the end of your driveway, not in the street.

Limbs and branches should be bundled and tied and may not exceed **4" in diameter, 4' in length or exceed 40 pounds.**

Garbage cans ARE NOT allowed, they will be disposed of with the rest of the household waste.

Each bag should weigh **no more than 40 pounds.**

Wrap broken glass and sharp objects in newspaper and place them where they can't cause injury.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM FLUSHING: DISTRICTS 5-8

In April 2023, our Utilities Operations and Maintenance contractor (Jacobs) began flushing the Villages Water Conservation Authority (VWCA) irrigation system located in Districts 5-8. Flushing prevents the accumulation of small particles and build-up, which can lead to plugging issues in our irrigation system. Due to the size of the VWCA system, the area has been divided into 90 distinct flushing zones. Once started, this project will take approximately 50 weeks to work through all 90 zones.



As the flushing takes place, you will see the Jacobs team opening fire hydrants and flushing irrigation lines only into the roadway. Work hours will be from 8 am to 5 pm. Information will be updated regularly on the District's website on when you can expect to see the Jacobs team in action in your area. Please continue to check the Weekly Bulletin or the [What's Happening](#) page on [DistrictGov.org](#) for updates.

This maintenance work will not have any effects on your drinking water quality nor pressure. This is a proactive effort to maintain your irrigation system.

The safety of residents and contractor personnel is of the utmost importance. We are requesting everyone to abide by all barricades and warning signs and to avoid the active work area for anything other than access to your property.

Thank you for your cooperation and patience as we improve our irrigation system. If you have any questions or would like additional information, please contact District Utilities at 352-753-4022.

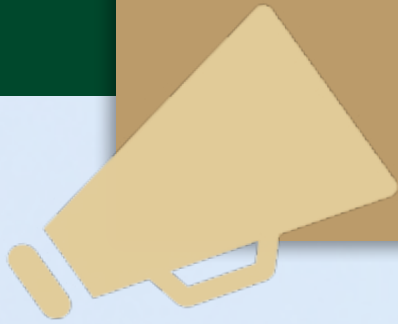
