## Age Requirements

Visiting children, with valid guest Id cards, must be 13 years of age

and accompanied by a Villages resident or a guest 19 years of age or older with a valid guest ID card and photo ID, at all times, to use the air gun, archery, billiards, croquet, lawn bowling and dog park facilities.

Valid guests must be 19 years of age to use the Fitness Clubs when open.

## Lost and Found

Depending on where items are found, inexpensive items will be held for one month at La Hacienda, Laurel Manor, Eisenhower or Everglades Regional Recreation Centers. Valuables will be turned over to the Lady Lake Police Department, Sumter County Sheriff's Office or Marion County Sheriff's Office within 72 hours.

At the end of each month, unclaimed items will be donated to local charities. The Recreation & Parks Department is not responsible for lost items.

## Residents living in Village Community Development Districts 1-11, located in Sumter County, Marion County and The Villages of Fruitland Park

The following items can be placed in your regular household waste pick-up:

- Lamps
- Plastic Chairs
- Ceiling fans (blades must be removed)
- Brooms
- Pallets
- Carpeting and/or padding (No larger than 4' x 4' & less than 40 lbs.)
- 2-burner grills
- Flat-screen TVs
- Ironing boards
- Electronics (computers, stereo equipment, monitors etc.)
- Furniture (oversized chairs, mattresses, box springs, etc.)
- Appliances (washer, dryer, dishwasher, refrigerator)
- Lawn Mowers
- Exercise Equipment
- Remodeling debris generated by the homeowner ONLY (sinks, toilets, carpeting, lumber etc.)  
All Contractors are required to remove all debris from their jobs. This includes lawn maintenance, tree trimmers, builders, carpet installers, roofers, etc.

## A Bulk Item Pick-Up will need to be scheduled for larger items such as:

- Microwaves and small kitchen appliances
- Office chairs/desk chairs/kitchen chairs

To schedule a bulk pick-up, call 352-748-0109. There will be a \$10 charge added to your utilities and amenities bill each time a bulk pick-up is requested.

### HOW TO PACKAGE AND TRANSPORT CHEMICALS

<b>What not to bring:</b>		
Biological/Infectious waste	Explosives	Radioactive waste

1. Do NOT mix chemicals together.
2. Keep products in original labeled containers if possible.
3. Place containers into cardboard boxes to prevent breakage.
4. Place leaky container in clear plastic bag and transport in box with newspaper.
5. Put boxes in trunk or in back of vehicle away from passengers.

# Focusing on Mental Health and Happiness

## **The Link Between Health and Happiness**

Happiness is a positive emotion that can include feelings of gladness, satisfaction, joy and well-being. Many Americans desire happy, fulfilling lives. However, happiness is not an isolated feeling. It's complex and connected to your overall physical and mental health.

## **Happiness and Physical Health**

A study published in the Psychological Science Journal found a link between happiness and physical health. When your body is healthy, it serves as a foundation for happiness to thrive. Exercise, diet and sleep all play vital roles in facilitating health and happiness.

The body releases natural feelgood chemicals known as endorphins during physical activity. This can improve mood and reduce stress and anxiety. Physical activity also improves cardiovascular health and boosts energy levels.

A balanced diet of lean proteins, fresh fruits and vegetables, whole grains and healthy fats can support improved cognitive function, emotional stability and overall well-being.

Sleep is another factor that impacts health and happiness. Studies show that quality sleep can improve focus, mental health, cognitive performance and emotional resilience.

# Focusing on Mental Health and Happiness

## Do You Know About 988?

The 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline hotline was launched in 2022 to help people in emotional distress or a suicidal crisis. Similar to how 911 exists for medical emergencies, this three-digit code was created for psychological emergencies.

Anyone can call or text 988 to be immediately connected with trained mental health counselors who will listen and provide support. Counselors may also connect you with additional resources if necessary.

You may call 988 for various mental health crises, including but not limited to self-harm, addiction and suicidal ideation. You can also call 988 on behalf of another person to help a friend or family member get through a difficult time.

## What is 988?

The three-digit code, 988, is new, but the Suicide and Crisis Lifeline has existed since 2005 and received over 20 million calls.

Previously, callers could only reach the Suicide and Crisis Lifeline by dialing 1-800-273-8255 (TALK). However, experts worried the number was too

difficult to remember, prompting them to launch the new 988 code.

The same services are available whether you call the original Suicide and Crisis Lifeline or call or text 988.

## Spreading the Word

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), suicide was among the top 9 leading causes of death among people ages 10-64 in 2021. It was the second leading cause of death among people ages 10-12 and 20-34.

The Suicide and Crisis Lifeline provides accessible care to anyone experiencing distress, substance abuse, suicidal thoughts or mental health crisis. Share the new code to family and friends.

### **C 466A Resurfacing Scheduled from Buena Vista Boulevard to Lake County Line**

Sumter County, FL – Resurfacing on certain portions of C 466A from Buena Vista Blvd. to the Lake County line will begin August 13, 2023. The project should be completed within four weeks. Nighttime lane closures will occur from 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. Please use caution when traveling C 466A to protect yourself and construction workers. Partial lane closures are to be expected, and heavy machinery will be working near the travel way.

### **Buena Vista Boulevard Southbound to be Closed Between C 466A and St. Charles Place/Turtle Mound Path**

Sumter County, FL – The southbound lanes on Buena Vista Boulevard between C 466A and St. Charles Place/Turtle Mound Path will be closed Thursday, August 24 and Friday, August 25 for median excavation and installation of stormwater pipe liner.

If you are traveling on Buena Vista Boulevard South Bound to go to C 466A, use Odell Circle as a detour. Make a left on Odell Circle, traveling eastbound, and then turn right on Canal street to get to 466A.

In addition, the northbound lanes on Buena Vista Blvd. will be closed from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on August 24.

Detour signs will be setup on Wednesday, August 23. Traffic detour will begin on Thursday, August 24. Please follow the posted detour signs.

Please use caution when traveling Buena Vista Boulevard and C 466A. Follow the traffic signs to protect yourself and construction workers.

# IRRIGATION SYSTEM FLUSHING: DISTRICTS 5-8

In April 2023, our Utilities Operations and Maintenance contractor (Jacobs) began flushing the Villages Water Conservation Authority (VWCA) irrigation system located in Districts 5-8. Flushing prevents the accumulation of small particles and build-up, which can lead to plugging issues in our irrigation system. Due to the size of the VWCA system, the area has been divided into 90 distinct flushing zones. Once started, this project will take approximately 50 weeks to work through all 90 zones.



As the flushing takes place, you will see the Jacobs team opening fire hydrants and flushing irrigation lines only into the roadway. Work hours will be from 8 am to 5 pm. Information will be updated regularly on the District's website on when you can expect to see the Jacobs team in action in your area. Please continue to check the Weekly Bulletin or the [What's Happening](#) page on [DistrictGov.org](#) for updates.

This maintenance work will not have any effects on your drinking water quality nor pressure. This is a proactive effort to maintain your irrigation system.

The safety of residents and contractor personnel is of the utmost importance. We are requesting everyone to abide by all barricades and warning signs and to avoid the active work area for anything other than access to your property.

Thank you for your cooperation and patience as we improve our irrigation system. If you have any questions or would like additional information, please contact District Utilities at 352-753-4022.

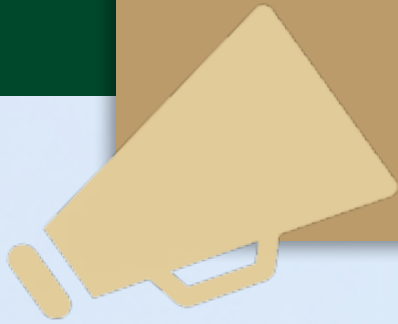
