Subject: Political Campaign Activities

Each election period raises questions about allowable campaign activities within The Villages Community Development Districts (District). In order to assist all Candidates, we have prepared the following overview. However, any questions with regard to activities allowed or prohibited should be directed to District Administration at (352) 751-3939.

Signs:

1. For information on displaying signage at your residence, please refer to your Declaration of Restrictions or contact Community Standards at 352-751-3912.
2. Signs may not be placed on, against, implanted, or affixed to the interior or exterior of District property. Signs placed on District property will be removed and the District is not liable for the return of removed signs.
3. No political campaign signs, flyers or related documents are to be posted on District bulletin boards and, if discovered, will be removed immediately.
4. Signs may be held by Candidates or their supporters.
5. Signs may be affixed to golf carts or Low-Speed Vehicles.

Election Day Polling Places:

1. Activities at polling places shall be in accordance with the interpretation of state statute or local ordinance by the applicable Supervisor of Elections. The Supervisor of Elections is the entity to interpret the statutes and local ordinances.
2. Persons in support of Candidates or issues shall not interfere with any member of the public accessing/using District property or voters attempting to enter a polling place located on District property.

Community Development District Public Facilities and District Government Employees

1. Candidates and their supporters are allowed to stand on the exterior of District property (i.e. postal facilities, recreation centers and at public events) in compliance with the Rules of the District.
2. Candidates and their supporters may hold signs or affix them to golf cars or Low Speed Vehicles.
3. Candidates and their supporters may not set up tables on District property. Candidates and their supporters are not allowed to interfere with persons attempting to access District facilities and/or activities.
4. Candidates are afforded the same opportunities as other persons or groups to reserve a room at a District Recreation Center in accordance with the published rates adopted in the respective Rate Rules.
5. No Candidate or their supporters shall solicit or knowingly accept any political contribution on any District Property, unless a room is reserved, as stated above, at a District Recreation Center for the specific purpose of hosting a fundraiser or similar function.

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6. Candidates and their supporters may not, in furtherance of their candidacy, use the services of District Government Employees during their scheduled working hours. District Government Employees also may not campaign for Candidates or political issues while in their official capacity or use the District's resources in furtherance thereof.

Per District Legal Counsel, a reminder as to:

- Fla. Stat. s. 102.031(4)(a): No person, political committee, or other group or organization may solicit voters inside the polling place or within 150 feet of the entrance to any polling place, a polling room where the polling place is also a polling room, an early voting site, or an office of the supervisor where vote-by-mail ballots are requested and printed on demand for the convenience of electors who appear in person to request them. Before the opening of the polling place or early voting site, the clerk or supervisor shall designate the no-solicitation zone and mark the boundaries.
- Fla. Stat. s. 102.031(4)(e): The owner, operator, or lessee of the property on which a polling place or an early voting site is located, or an agent or employee thereof, may not prohibit the solicitation of voters outside of the no-solicitation zone during polling hours.

Subject: Soliciting at Swimming Pools, Postal Facilities, & Recreation Centers

No person, political committee, or other group or organization may solicit or fundraise at District-owned Postal Facilities, Swimming Pools, and Recreation Centers, or the land they encompass, including the sidewalk and parking lot. Signs may not be placed on, against, implanted, or affixed to the interior or exterior of District property. Signs placed on District property will be removed and the District is not liable for the return of removed signs. Persons shall not interfere with any member of the public accessing/using District property. There are no live performance musicians, bands, or Karaoke allowed. No Parades, street festivals, demonstrations, rallies, circus', fairs, carnivals, picket lines, flea markets, street vendors, soliciting of contributions, erecting permanent or temporary structures, including tables, and similar activities, are permitted within the Districts, except with the approval of the District Manager.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is your sewer backing up? Is water flowing out of your yard and down the street?

If your answer is yes, call us at 352-750-0000!

The District Utilities Department and our contractor Jacobs are responsible for maintaining the water and sewer mains that service your home for the majority of areas within The Villages. If you reside in Phillips Villas or Soulliere Villas, please contact Marion County Utilities at 352-307-6000 for sewer issues. For all other residents, please contact the District at 352-750-0000.

For water service, the utility provider's responsibility ends at the brass portion of the water meter and the homeowner's responsibility begins at the PVC connection side of the water meter. For sewer service, the utility provider's responsibility ends at the 6" cleanout located in the utility right of way in the front of your home.

If your lights go out, you typically would call the electric company to confirm whether or not there is a problem with their service. For water or sewer issues, many people tend to call a plumber first. Please call us at 352-750-0000 so that we can evaluate our side of the sewer system and determine where the issue is located. If it is found that the issue is on the District side, we will make repairs. If the issue is on the homeowner's side, we will let you know so you can contact a repair provider such as a plumber.

Please note that the District will not evaluate any issues with leaking water inside your home, only sewer issues.

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GOLF CAR RULES OF THE ROAD AND SAFETY TIPS

When traveling in a golf car through The Villages Community on a roadway or multi-modal path, we urge you to follow these rules of the road and safety tips to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone. The multi-modal paths are designated for use by non-automotive, non-vehicular traffic such as bicycles, golf cars and pedestrians.

Slow Down and Enjoy The Ride!

BEFORE YOU DRIVE

- Make sure the horn, brakes and lights work.
- Check back-up alarm, tire pressure and applicable gauges.
- Before backing up, look behind and see that all is clear.





RULES OF THE ROAD

- Golf car drivers must possess a valid form of government-issued photographic identification
- Drivers under 18 years of age must possess a valid driver's license or learner's driver's license
- Drive on neighborhood streets, marked roadside lanes, and multi-modal paths
- Obey all traffic laws, signs and signals
- Golf cars are subject to Florida's open alcoholic container laws
- Speed not to exceed 20mph
- Use hand and turn signals
- Yield to automobiles
- Come to a full stop at stop signs
- Never enter a roundabout in a golf car
- Golf cars are prohibited from roadways with posted speeds of 35mph or more

SAFETY TIPS

- Provide a seat for each person/pet
- Secure all children and pets
- Keep passengers seated in golf car at all times
- Keep arms and legs inside golf car at all times
- Enter traffic lane safely before turning left
- Be aware of vehicles turning right (across the golf car lane)
- Maintain golf car according to manufacturer's recommendations
- Do not text/phone while driving
- Limit passing slower golf cars
- Pull off the path when you need to stop

The Lake Sumter Landing Wilkerson Creek Walking Trail will be closed for replacement from the Covered Bridge behind Barnes and Noble to Old Camp Road for three weeks beginning on September 18, 2023.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM FLUSHING: DISTRICTS 5-8

In April 2023, our Utilities Operations and Maintenance contractor (Jacobs) began flushing the Villages Water Conservation Authority (VWCA) irrigation system located in Districts 5-8. Flushing prevents the accumulation of small particles and build-up, which can lead to plugging issues in our irrigation system. Due to the size of the VWCA system, the area has been divided into 90 distinct flushing zones. Once started, this project will take approximately 50 weeks to work through all 90 zones.



As the flushing takes place, you will see the Jacobs team opening fire hydrants and flushing irrigation lines only into the roadway. Work hours will be from 8 am to 5 pm. Information will be updated regularly on the District's website on when you can expect to see the Jacobs team in action in your area. This maintenance work will not have any effects on your drinking water quality nor pressure. This is a proactive effort to maintain your irrigation system.

The safety of residents and contractor personnel is of the utmost importance. We are requesting everyone to abide by all barricades and warning signs and to avoid the active work area for anything other than access to your property.
