A Message from the District Manager

Villages Public Safety Department Dependent District (VPSDDD)



After public input and a public hearing at Tuesday night's Sumter County Board Of County Commissioners (BOCC) meeting, the Commissioners unanimously voted in favor of the Ordinance creating the Villages Public Safety Department Dependent District (VPSDDD).

This marks a significant stride toward empowering residents within the service delivery area in Sumter County. The establishment of a resident-led Board ensures oversight of how the public safety needs within The Villages are met and funded. The upcoming task of determining special assessment methodology and rates is a substantial endeavor, but one that promises benefits for all residents. The first Board meeting will be held on December 15, 2023 at 10 AM at the Savannah Center. This organizational meeting will cover key aspects, including the election of the Chair and Vice Chair, the hiring of essential services such as VCCDD for management and legal representation, as well as an overview of the organizational structure of VPSD and its operational framework.

Additionally, we will delve into the current funding structure of VPSD and discuss how VPSDDD will contribute to shaping this financial landscape. Your support has been instrumental in reaching this milestone, and we extend our gratitude to everyone, including the County Commissioners, for their dedication.

Together, we are shaping a future where public safety services meet the expectations and standards that residents of The Villages have grown accustomed to over the years. I want to thank everyone for their support in this endeavor, including the County Commissioners, so that we may have the ability to serve the residents and the levels they have become accustomed to over the years.


I BET YOU DIDN'T KNOW...

Holiday Season Safety

Provided by Risk Management

The holiday season is upon us. Be aware that holiday safety issues tend to spike from late November to mid-January with holiday decorating, parties and travel.

Decorating:

- If using an artificial tree, make sure it is labeled as “fire resistant.” Place your tree a minimum of 3 feet away from heat sources, fireplaces, heating vents and radiators.
- Make sure your tree does not block doorways, walking areas or escape routes.
- Avoid using ornaments that are breakable.
- Use indoor lights indoors and outdoor lights outdoors.
- Avoid using lights that have broken or cracked sockets, frayed/bare wires and loose connections.
- Follow directions on the number of lights that can be plugged into one socket.
- Do not tack, nail, or stress wiring

when hanging lights. Keep the plug off the ground away from puddling due to rain or sprinklers.

- Consider flameless candles.
- Turn off all lights and decorations before you leave.

Food Safety

Food poisoning is very serious — at holiday parties serving food, always remember:

- Wash your hands before handling food.
- Keep raw meats away from fresh produce.
- Have appropriate utensils ready for all food items to avoid cross-contamination.
- Avoid serving undercooked meats.

Winter Holiday Safety

Winter holidays are a time for families and friends to get together. But that also means a greater risk for fire. Following a few simple tips will ensure a happy and fire-safe holiday season.

HOLIDAY DECORATING

- Be careful with holiday decorations. Choose decorations that are flame resistant or flame retardant.
- Keep lit candles away from decorations and other things that can burn.
- Some lights are only for indoor or outdoor use, but not both.
- Replace any string of lights with worn or broken cords or loose bulb connections. Read manufacturer's instructions for number of light strands to connect.
- Use clips, not nails, to hang lights so the cords do not get damaged.
- Keep decorations away from windows and doors.

HOLIDAY ENTERTAINING

- Test your smoke alarms and tell guests about your home fire escape plan.
- Keep children and pets away from lit candles.
- Keep matches and lighters up high in a locked cabinet.
- Stay in the kitchen when cooking on the stovetop.
- Ask smokers to smoke outside. Remind smokers to keep their smoking materials with them so young children do not touch them.
- Provide large, deep ashtrays for smokers. Wet cigarette butts with water before discarding.



Before Heading Out or to Bed

Blow out lit candles when you leave the room or go to bed. **Turn off** all light strings and decorations before leaving home or going to bed.

FACTS

- ! More than **one-third** of home decoration fires are started by candles.
- ! More than **two of every five** decoration fires happen because decorations are placed too close to a heat source.

Information Provided By...



Easements and rights-of-way refer to areas of property that utilities have permission to use. These are usually located in and along streets and roadways and are necessary for ongoing utility maintenance.

Residents who choose to enhance their driveways with improvements such as brick pavers or painting that encroach on the right of way, should be aware that the Utility is not responsible for any

damage, loss or costs incurred should it be necessary to remove sections of the driveway for repairs or maintenance to the water or wastewater utility system. The Utility will restore the driveway to the original finish only.


Project Description

The historic Moving Florida Forward Infrastructure Initiative (fdot.gov/movingfloridaforward) is allowing the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to advance much-needed improvements to Interstate 75 (I-75) in Central Florida, with construction anticipated to begin in spring 2025.

The I-75 Improvements projects are located between State Road (S.R.) 44 in Sumter County and S.R. 326 in Marion County, covering approximately 30 miles. The improvements include the addition of an auxiliary lane in each direction and interchange improvements at S.R. 326 and S.R. 40.

An auxiliary lane is an extra lane connecting the on and off ramps between two consecutive interchanges that reduces congestion by giving drivers more space and time to merge safely.

The I-75 improvements are currently being evaluated under two separate Project Development and Environment (PD&E) studies. I-75 South begins south of S.R. 44 and ends at S.R. 200. I-75 North begins at S.R. 200 and ends at S.R. 326.





Road Closure

Updated 10/9/2023

District Property Management will be performing restoration for a stormwater pipe that will require a closure of the westbound golf cart lane on Bichara Boulevard northwest of the intersection of US 441 and Bichara Blvd near the Wendy's restaurant. Golf carts will be merged temporarily into automobile traffic before returning to the golf cart lane. The closure will begin Friday, October 6, 2023 and will continue indefinitely until stormwater restoration is completed as soon as possible. Please pay attention to the flow of traffic and use caution when approaching the lane merge. We appreciate your patience as we strive to provide the best service possible and ensure the District's assets are preserved for our community. Irrigation Line Repair

Updated 11/28/2023

Due to a needed repair to our irrigation system, the multi-modal path north of Belvedere Blvd at the Village of Bonnybrook entrance will be closed Monday, December 4, 2023 for up to three days while the work is completed. Residents should use the Laurel Manor and Rainey Trail tunnels to avoid the area during this time. The safety of our residents and construction personnel is of the utmost importance. We are requesting everyone to abide by all barricades and warning signs and to avoid the active construction area. Thank you for your cooperation and patience while the repair is underway. IRRIGATION SYSTEM FLUSHING: DISTRICTS 5-8

In April 2023, our Utilities Operations and Maintenance contractor (Jacobs) began flushing the Villages Water Conservation Authority (VWCA) irrigation system located in Districts 5-8. Flushing prevents the accumulation of small particles and build-up, which can lead to plugging issues in our irrigation system. Due to the size of the VWCA system, the area has been divided into 90 distinct flushing zones. Once started, this project will take approximately 50 weeks to work through all 90 zones.



As the flushing takes place, you will see the Jacobs team opening fire hydrants and flushing irrigation lines only into the roadway. Work hours will be from 8 am to 5 pm. Information will be updated regularly on the District's website on when you can expect to see the Jacobs team in action in your area. Please continue to check the Weekly Bulletin or the [What's Happening](#) page on [DistrictGov.org](#) for updates.

This maintenance work will not have any effects on your drinking water quality nor pressure. This is a proactive effort to maintain your irrigation system.

The safety of residents and contractor personnel is of the utmost importance. We are requesting everyone to abide by all barricades and warning signs and to avoid the active work area for anything other than access to your property.
