Wildwood's Lake Deaton Park Project to Begin Feb. 19

Park Will be Closed Temporarily While Improvements are Under Construction

Wildwood officials are advising the public that Lake Deaton Park will close temporarily Monday, Feb. 19, for a major park improvement project. The closure will remain in effect while construction crews and equipment are on site.

"While we understand Lake Deaton is an extremely popular site for boating, fishing, and other passive recreation, we always prioritize public safety," explained Interim Parks and Recreation Director Jason Wheeler. "When finished, the work will provide a greatly enhanced experience as a reward for the temporarily inconvenience."

The improvement project includes significant upgrades to the facility's heavily used boat ramp, fishing pier, pavement, and signage. Work is anticipated to be complete by the end of April, barring unforeseen delays.

The park will reopen as soon as construction crews have demobilized.

e-Billing AVAILABLE

e-Billing is available for your monthly water, trash and amenity bill! By signing up for e-Bill, we will no longer send you a monthly paper statement. Bond Payment Cut-Off Date-March 15, 2024

If you still have a Bond balance on your Villages home, you can continue to pay the Bond through the annual assessment on your County property tax bill, or you may choose to prepay the remaining Principal balance at any time. If you are interested in paying off your Bond in full, you will save half the interest for the year if we receive your payoff check before the end of business on Friday, March 15, 2024. You will also eliminate the annual Bond assessment on your November 2024 tax bill and avoid future interest payments.

Please contact the Bond office at 352-751-3900 to obtain your Bond payoff amount and instructions on how to submit your payment. Payments can be placed in the District Drop Boxes located at each Postal Station (up until March 11th) and the District Drop Box located outside the main office (until 5pm on March 15th.) Please call to schedule an appointment prior to visiting the office.

Please remember that even when the Bond is paid in full, there will continue to be an annual maintenance assessment on your County property tax bill which pays for ongoing costs to maintain the infrastructure of your District.
