



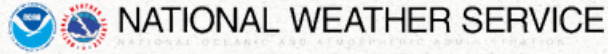

## Extreme Heat Planning Timeline

### Pre-Season

Start planning before hot weather arrives.

- ✓ Build an emergency kit
- ✓ Make a plan for power outages
- ✓ Become trained in first aid for heat-related emergencies
- ✓ Check that your A/C and fans are in working order

### A Few Days Out

If the forecast calls for extreme heat, be ready.

- ✓ Gather food, water, and medication
- ✓ Make a list of friends and family to check on & help them prepare
- ✓ Know your local cooling shelters or other cool locations
- ✓ Reschedule outdoor events

### During and After

Remain vigilant and stay informed.

- ✓ Stay in air conditioning and out of the sun if possible
- ✓ Check on friends, family, neighbors, and pets
- ✓ Drink plenty of water
- ✓ Take breaks and use a buddy system if working outdoors

June brings the start of climatological summer, which means preparing yourself and loved ones (including your pets) for extreme weather, especially extreme heat, is a priority. The National Weather Service provides abundant resources on staying safe and informed on the best ways to beat the heat before, during, and after the effects of the hottest days of the year.

The **NWS HeatRisk** is an experimental color-numeric-based index that provides a forecast risk of heat-related impacts to occur over a 24-hour period. HeatRisk takes into consideration:

- How unusual the heat is for the time of the year
- The duration of the heat including both daytime and nighttime temperatures
- If those temperatures pose an elevated risk of heat-related impacts based on data from the CDC

This index is supplementary to official NWS heat products and is meant to provide risk guidance for those decision makers and heat-sensitive populations who need to take actions at levels that may be below current NWS heat product levels. Read more about summer safety [here!](#)

# HOLIDAY SANITATION



## **Village Community Development Districts 1 – 11**

If you live in Village Community Development Districts 1 – 11 located in Sumter County, Marion County or Fruitland Park portions of The Villages, there will be normal residential sanitation collection on Thursday, July 4, 2024.

## **Village Community Development District 12 and the Villages of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney**

If you live in Village Community Development District 12 or the Village of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney, there will be normal residential sanitation collection for the week.

## **Village Community Development District 13 (excluding the Villages of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney) and District 14**

If you live in Village Community Development District 13 (excluding Village of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney) and District 14, there will be no residential collection on Thursday, July 4, 2024. The next collection date will be on Monday, July 8, 2024.

If you live in the **Town of Lady Lake portion of The Villages**, there will be no residential sanitation collection on Thursday, July 4, 2024. The next collection date will be on Monday, July 8, 2024.

If you live in the **Lake County portion of The Villages** (not including VCDD Nos. 11 or 14), there will be no sanitation collection on Thursday, July 4, 2024. Collection will occur on Friday and all remaining collection days for the week will be moved to the next day.

If you live in the **Middleton Community Development District**, there will be no sanitation schedule change due to the holiday.

# Fiber Optic Utility Easement Work

Please be advised that fiber optic utility easement work will be taking place in Village Community Development District No. 7 over the coming weeks and months.

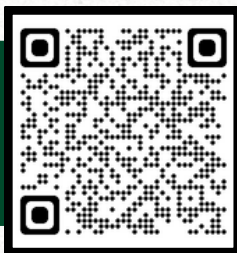
